Three Brothers Die Within Ten Weeks

Imley Sharp Soon Follows His Brother, John, of Port Norris, in Last Journey

Port Norris.—The passing of Imley Sharp at Mays Landing last week, at the age of 73, made the demise of three brothers in less than 10 weeks.

Just one week elapsed between the death of Imley and that of the oldest brother John of this place. Both died on Wednesday and were buried the Sunday following. The third brother, Enoch, also of Port Norris, died January 7.

They were sons of Mr. and Mrs. Peter Sharp and were natives of Halesville. The remains of Imley were brought to Halesville church, Sunday afternoon, where funeral services were held by his pastor from Mays Landing.

Mr. Sharp had been ailing for a long time at the home of his daughter, Mrs. William Taylor. He also leaves two sons, Albert, of Vineland, and Raymond, of Mays Landing.

There are also two surviving brothers, Reuben, of Maurice-town, and Peter, of Halesville.
