By Virtue of a Warrant from the Council of Proprietors of the Western Division of the State of New Jersey to the Surveyor General directed bearing date the Third day of the Second Month Eighteen hundred & twenty nine requiring him or some of his Lawful Deputies to Resurvey for Jonas Miller, Daniel Rose, and James Tickle; all or any part of their Lands in the Western Division aforesaid First giving timely notice to all persons concerned in the adjoining Lines By Virtue whereof on the Twenty fourth day of the third Month A.D. 1831 on the said Jonas Miller's Stating that timely notice had been given to all persons known to be concerned in the Lines I began a Resurvey for the said Miller on the 6th day of June 1769 Daniel Rose & James Tickle on a survey of Twenty five Acres formerly made to Hugh McCollum Situate in the Township of Galway; Jesse McCollum & Samuel McCollum being sworn as Chain Bares and Patrick McCollum who was one of the chain bares when the Survey was made appearing & Testifying to the Beginning corner ^{as near as he could recollect} named in said Survey and called the third corner of John Garrish 150 Acres Surveyed the 4th day of the 3rd M^o 1741. and recorded in the Surveyor General's office at Burlington in Lib. A. fol. 374. Standing one Chain and Thirtysix Links from the New Road from Port Republic to Blaikie's landing the Chimney of James H. Blaikie's house bares South Forty eight Degrees East Thirteen Chains & fifty Links being an old Dead Pine antiently Marked four Blaikie's twelve Sotches a Black Oak Scent close by the said Pine also corner Marked and extends from thence first North Fifty two Degrees East ^{as reported by the Testimony of Patrick McCollum} seventeen & a quarter chains to a hamack in a Branch by an old road that they ran over when the Survey was made and once since and at the end of Fifty chains and fifty Links to a Post crossing said Branch twice (2) North Forty six Degrees East Eleven chains and Sixty Links crossing a Branch to a Post on the South East side thereof (3) thence North Seventeen chains and Seventy five Links to an antient Pine corner called Hollin Head corner (4) North Nineteen Degrees East Three chains and Twenty Links to a small Cedar ~~—~~ Marked for a corner of a Resurvey standing near where Patrick McCollum said the corner of the said Hugh McCollum Meadow survey formerly stood (5) ^{of 70 acres} North Thirty seven Degrees West Two chains and ninety Links to an old pine stump at which the original survey cornered ^{as reported by the oath affirmation of the} Patrick McCollum at the North West side of the cross way over Gum Branch thence (6) South Nineteen Degrees East Five chains and Forty Links along the West side of the cross way to a pine stump said by the said Jesse & Samuel McCollum to be corner Marked when the tree was standing thence (7) South Six Degrees & forty Minutes West twelve chains and ~~forty~~ Twenty Links to a Post on the South side of a Branch and a Part of small Cedars Marked as witnesses around (8) South Forty six Degrees West by a line of Marked Trees Twenty two chains and Twenty five ~~Chains~~ Links to a small Pine Marked for a corner in a Gum Branch near the Run, thence (9) West five chains and Forty Links to a Post on the South side of a Gum Branch thence (10) South sixty five Degrees West Thirty five chains part by a line of Marked ^{trees} to a Post on Rising Ground (11) South Thirteen chain and ten ~~chains~~ Links to a Post on a Ridge of Land thence (12) South Eighty Degrees East Nine chains and Fifty Links to the place of Beginning containing twenty four acres and twenty three hundredth with allowance for Roads making an over plus of Fortynine acres and Twenty three hundredth of an acre. To which over plus I have appropriated the like quantity of Rights to unlocated Lands which the said Jonas Miller, Daniel Rose & James Tickle became seized of by virtue of a Deed of Conveyance from Burr Woolman Esq; Attorney for Thomas & Greene by Deed bearing date the third day of March A.D. 1829. To Which Land the said Jonas Miller, Daniel Rose & James Tickle claims Title as followeth. Whereas Hugh McCollum had Surveyed for him a Tract of Land containing Twenty five acres on the 6th day of the 4th M^o 1769. Recorded in the Surveyor General's Office at Burlington in Lib. B fol. 321. Who by his Last ^{will} and Testament devised it unto his son Malcom McCollum with a proviso that if the said Malcom should die & leave no Issue then it was to Decend to his Daughter Mary Johnston the wife of Jonathan Johnston, & the said Malcom so dying and leaving no Issue it descended to the said Mary. And she conveyed it by Deed jointly to Hugh Johnston & Thomas Dixon, and the said Hugh Johnston by Deed dated the 17th of the 12th M^o 1828 Conveyed his Moiety unto James Tickle, and the said Thomas Dixon by Deed conveyed his Moiety unto Patrick McCambridge who by Deed dated the 2nd day of the 12th M^o 1828 Conveyed his Moiety unto Daniel Rose. And the said Rose & Tickle being so thereof Seized die by Deed bearing date the 13th day of the 1st M^o 1829 in equal proportions Convey one equal undivided third part thereof unto the said Jonas Miller for whom I have made the foregoing Resurvey. 

The above is the draught of the Survey made for Jonas Mallet, Daniel Rose & James Tickle on a Survey formerly made for Hugh McCollum for Twenty five acres situate in the Township of Galway which I commenced on the 2nd day of the 3rd M^o. A.D. 1829 & completed on the 12th day following and find that to go to its antient Calls Contains Seventy four acres and Twenty three hundredth making an over plus of Forty nine $\frac{23}{100}$ acres. The dotted lines are the strict measure with out paying any attention to the Calls as appears from the Record entered in the Surveyor Gen^l office at Burlington Lib O. Vol. 321.
