Daniel Walker Jun<sup>r</sup> We having preferred to this application addressed to His Excellency the Sec<sup>t</sup> Governor in Council for a grant of Two hundred Acres of land in the Township of Midland District We have examined into his character and pretensions and find that he is duly entitled to the benefit of the order in Council at Quebec dated the 9<sup>th</sup> Nov. 1789 being the son of Daniel Walker Sen<sup>r</sup> U.E loyalist and there being no default in the due cultivation and improvement of the lands already assigned to the said Daniel Walker U.E his Father in the Township of Earnest. in the Midland District

We therefore hereby assign to the said Daniel Walker Jun<sup>r</sup> U.E the Lot Number in the conception of the Township of in the District containing Two hundred Acres more or less the same being Vacant and the Petitioners name duly entered on the Plan and Schedule of locations of the said Township and the said Daniel Walker Jun<sup>r</sup> U.E is hereby authorized to occupy and improve the said lands and having improved the same he shall receive a grant thereof to him and his Heirs or Devisees in due form on such terms and conditions as it shall please His Majesty to ordain. And all persons are desired to take notice that this Assignment and all others of a similar nature are not transferable by purchase donation or otherwise on any pretence whatever except by an act under the signature of the Board for the District in which the lands are situated which is to be endorsed upon this Certificate.
