certain Attorney Executors Adm^{rs} or Assigns to the which Payment
well and Truly to be made I do bind myself & my heirs Executors
& Adm^{rs} simply by these Presents sealed with my seal Dated the
Twenty third day of December in the year of our Lord one
Thousand Seven Hundred & Sixty Two & in the year of the reign
of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the grace of God King
of Great Britain &c

The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above
bounden Daniel Robins or his heirs ex^{rs} or Adm^{rs} or any of them
shall and do well & Truly pay or cause to be paid to the above
Named John Head his certain Attorney ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} or Assigns
the just & full sum of one Hundred & forty three pounds 12s 3 with
Interest Lawfull money aforesaid on the Twenty third day of
February Next ensuing the day of the above date without any
Tard or further Delay then this above obligation to be void or
else to be & remain in full force & virtue
