at Trenton in the County of Hunterdon aforesaid & within the Juris-
diction of this Court was indebted to the said Henry in the Sum
of forty two Pounds Current Money of New York equal to
forty two Pounds proclamation Money for divers Goods wares
& Merchandizes by the said Henry to the said Daniel in his
Life time at his special Instance & Request before that
Time sold & delivered & being so thereof indebted he the said
Daniel in his Life time in Consideration thereof afterwards
to wit the same Day & Year aforesaid at Trenton aforesaid in the Coun-
ty & within the Jurisdiction aforesaid assumed upon himself & to
him the said Henry then & there faithfully promised that
he the said Daniel would well & truly pay the said forty two
Pounds to the said Henry Remson Junr when he the said Dani-
