

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Council of proprietors bearing date the 14 of May Anno 1718 Surveyed this Tract of Land unto Joseph Ridgdon lying in the old purchases on the Heads of hunbrocks which enythes then bluds unto the South Branch of Rungton River Neer to a pond of Water called Kant-Kria i running in the County of Hunterdon & Western Division of y^e Province of New Jersey

- 1 Beginning at a White oak Tree corner of Daniell Robins Land and marked D: Thence Northwesterly Sixty Degrees and Hundred & Sixty Chains to the corner Chestnut oak marked I.P.
- 2 Thence To the Westwardly thirty Degrees Two Hundred & Seventy five Chains to a corner Red Oak Tree marked II.P.
- 3 Thence South Westwardly Sixty Degrees Sixty Two Chains to a corner Chestnut Tree marked III.P.
- 4 Thence South Westwardly Ten Degrees and Hundred fifty and Chains crossing a branch of Muskonong River to a corner White oak Tree being corner of Benjamin Wrights Land marked E.K.
- 5 Thence Along his line North Eastwardly Sixty six Degrees forty two perches to his corner Chestnut Tree marked K.
- 6 Thence Still Along said Land Southwardly Thirty Degrees and Hundred Chains to his corner White oak tree marked R.
- 7 Thence Still along the line South Westwardly Sixty Degrees forty Two Chains to a corner Maple Tree of the Heaps Robins Land.
- 8 Thence Along his line Southwardly Thirty Degrees fifty six Chains to y^e first mentioned corner containing three thousand three Hundred & four score Acres of Land besides y^e usual allowance for Highways: Surveyed octob^r 8th and Nov^r 1718
