A Memorial of a Deed of Bargain & Sale, dated the twenty fifth  
of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and thirty one - Between James Lake 3<sup>d</sup> of the Township of Ernest  
Town in the Midland District and Province of Upper Canada,  
Plramid, of the first part - and John W. Dorn of the same Township  
Town aforesaid, Plramid of the second part - Whereas and Whereas  
the said James Lake 3<sup>d</sup> for the Consideration of the sum of two  
hundred & fifty pounds of the lawful Money of the Province of  
Upper Canada, the Receipt Whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
hath and doth Give Grant Bargain sell, assign & then transfer  
Convey & Confirm unto the Said John W. Dorn his heirs and  
Assigns - all that certain tract or parcel of land situated  
in the Township of Ernest Town aforesaid and composed of the North half of Lot  
Number Eighteen in the fourth Concession of the said Township, containing by  
a measurement One hundred acres be the same more or less, and are bounded and  
lotted bounded or may be otherwise known as follows - (that is to say) Commence  
ing in the middle of the said Concession at the South East angle of the said  
half lot, where the Road now crosses said lot - then North twenty four and a  
half degrees West fifty two Chains, sixty three links, to the allowance for Road  
in Rear of the said Concession - then South Sixty five degrees and a half West  
Nineteen Chains to the limits between lots number Seventeen & Eighteen -  
then South twenty four and a half degrees East, fifty two Chains, sixty  
three links to the said Road - then North Sixty five degrees and half  
East along the said Road Nineteen Chains more or less to the place of  
beginning - To have and to hold the said Granted premises with  
all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong to the said John W. Dorn  
his heirs and Assigns to their own use for ever - with Covenants of Seisin  
Right to transfer, freedom from incumbrances, quiet enjoyment, and  
General Warranty - subject however to the reservations and Conditions  
contained in the original Grant thereof from the Crown - Which Deed  
is witnessed by John Lake and Nathan Tullow, both of the Township  
of Ernest Town aforesaid, Plramids and this Memorial thereof is hereby  
required by the John W. Dorn the Grantee aforesaid to be Registered pursuant  
to Law - In Testimony Whereof the said John W. Dorn hereunto sets  
his hand and Seal the ninth day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand  
Eight hundred and thirty two -
