A Memorial of a Deed of Bargain & Sale, dated the  
fifteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand  
and eight hundred and twenty nine, Between John  
Lake of the Township of Ernest Town, yeoman,  
of the first part and Barnabas Bidwell of the Town  
of Kingston, Esquire, of the second part, Wherin  
and whereby the Said John Lake for the Consideration  
of the sum of One hundred and fifty pounds of  
the lawful Money of the Province of Upper Canada,  
the receipt whereof is acknowledged hath and doth  
give, and Grant, bargain, sells, assigns, releases trans-  
fers, conveys and Confirm unto the Said Barnabas  
Bidwell his heirs and assigns, all that certain  
tract or parcel of land situated in the Township  
of Ernest Town in the County of Addington in the  
Midland District, containing by admeasurement  
one hundred and fifty acres, to the same more or  
being the western three quarters of lot number

twenty in the ninth Concession of the said Township of Ernest  
Town, which said one hundred and fifty acres of land, are better  
and bounded or may be otherwise known as follows; that is to say,  
beginning at a post in front of the said concession four chains twenty  
five links distant from the South East angle of the said lot number  
twenty, and fourteen chains, seventy five links, from the South west  
angle thereof, then North twenty four degrees and a half West the  
said and five chains twenty seven links, then south thirty five degrees  
and a half West fourteen chains seventy five links, then South twenty  
four degrees and a half East, one hundred and five chains twenty  
seven links, then North sixty five degrees and a half East fourteen chains

seventy five links, to the place of Beginning.  
To have and to hold the said Granted premises, with all the privileges  
& appurtenances thereto to him the said Barnabas Bidwell his heirs &  
assigns, to their own use for ever; with Covenants of Seizure, right to transfer,  
freedom from incumbrances, quiet enjoyment and general Warrenty  
subject however to the reservations and conditions contained in the

original Grant thereof from the Crown,  
which Deed is witnessed by Nathan Fellowes of the Township of Ernest  
Town, yeoman, and William Benjamin Wells, of the Town of Kingston,  
gentleman, and this Memorial thereof, is required by John Lake  
the grantor aforesaid, to be Registered pursuant to law.

Provided, however, and the said Deed of Bargain & Sale is upon the  
condition that if the said John Lake his executors, Administrators  
& assigns, shall pay or cause to be paid, to the said Barnabas Bidwell,  
heirs executors, administrators or assigns the sum of One hundred &  
fifty pounds of lawful money of Upper Canada, with lawful interest  
thereon, in three years from the date thereof, according to the condition  
of his bond of even date therewith, then the said Deed shall be void, otherwise  
remain in full force, said John Lake to be at expence of the Deed & Register fees

In Testimony whereof the said John Lake hereunto sets his hand and seal  
the fifteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &  
twenty nine.
