Esquire all that certain tract or parcel of land lying sevale and being in the township of Caledonia in the county of Addington in the Midland District containing by estimation one hundred and forty acres of lands the same more or less being the western three quarters of lot number twenty and the north quarters of lot number nineteen with the fourth concession of the said Township of Caledonia together with the forty feet road between lot number nineteen and lot number twenty which said one hundred acres are settled and bounded or may otherwise be known as follows that is to say commencing where a post has been planted at the south east angle of the said westerly three quarters of lot number twenty being North twenty four and a half degrees west one hundred and four chains twenty seven links and one-half to the Allotment for Road with the rear of said concession being North fifty four and a half degrees West thirty three chains twenty five links more or less to the limits between lot number eighteen and lot number nineteen then south twenty four and a half degrees east twenty six chains twenty nine links to one quarter of the length of said concession then north forty five degrees and a half and nineteen chains to the limit between lot number nineteen and number twenty three south twenty four and a half degrees east fourteen chains twenty four links to the said more or less to the place of beginning to have and to hold the said granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Isaac Fraser his heirs and assigns to their use given with covenants of strict right to transfer freedom from incumbrances quiet enjoyment and general warranty subject however to the reservations and conditions contained in the original grant thereof from the Crown District however and the deed of bargain and sale is upon the condition that if the said Isaac Richard Joseph Fraser shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Nathan Fellowes of the execution of this Memorial or assignee the sum of Three hundred and one thousand dollars to which it shall be mostly paid before or on the 21st day of September 1853 by the terms of these presents to be paid at any time that the said Isaac Fraser shall think proper so that the said fair full interest thereon be paid within oath of Nathan Fellowes of or died shall leave and bequeath the Township of Caledonia to be distributed by Nathan Fellowes of the and town of Upper Canada Yeoman one of the of Nugent District and Province aforesaid Subscribing Witnessed by Isaac Richard Joseph Fraser the 21st day of September 1853 and William Edward

A Memorial of a deed of bargain and sale dated the eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three Isaac Richard Joseph Fraser of the Township of Caledonia in the Midland District and Province of Upper Canada Gentleman of the first part and John Lake of the Township of Caledonia Midland District and Province aforesaid gentleman of the second part witness and whereby the said Isaac Richard Joseph Fraser and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty pounds of the lawful money of the Province of Upper Canada by the said John Lake to him in hand and ready body paid the sum aforesaid whereby acknowledged each party bargained sold agreed released

conveyed and confirmed unto the said John Lake his heirs and assigns all that certain tract or parcel of land lying sevale and being in the township of Caledonia in the county of Addington in the Midland District containing by estimation one hundred and forty acres of lands the same more or less being the western three quarters of lot number twenty and the north

quarters of lot number nineteen with the fourth concession of the said Township of Caledonia together with the forty feet road between lot number nineteen and lot number twenty which said one hundred acres are settled and bounded or may otherwise be known as follows that is to say commencing where a post has been planted at the south east angle of the said westerly three quarters of lot number twenty being North twenty four and a half degrees west one hundred and four chains twenty seven links and one-half to the Allotment for Road with the rear of said concession being North fifty four and a half degrees West thirty three chains twenty five links more or less to the limits between lot number eighteen and lot number nineteen then south twenty four and a half degrees east twenty six chains twenty nine links to one quarter of the length of said concession then north forty five degrees and a half and nineteen chains to the limit between lot number nineteen and number twenty three south twenty four and a half degrees east fourteen chains twenty four links to the said more or less to the place of beginning to have and to hold the said granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Isaac Fraser his heirs and assigns to their use given with covenants of strict right to transfer freedom from incumbrances quiet enjoyment and general warranty subject however to the reservations and conditions contained in the original grant thereof from the Crown District however and the deed of bargain and sale is upon the condition that if the said Isaac Richard Joseph Fraser shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Nathan Fellowes of the execution of this Memorial or assignee the sum of Three hundred and one thousand dollars to which it shall be mostly paid before or on the 21st day of September 1853 by the terms of these presents to be paid at any time that the said Isaac Fraser shall think proper so that the said fair full interest thereon be paid within oath of Nathan Fellowes of or died shall leave and bequeath the Township of Caledonia to be distributed by Nathan Fellowes of the and town of Upper Canada Yeoman one of the of Nugent District and Province aforesaid Subscribing Witnessed by Isaac Richard Joseph Fraser the 21st day of September 1853 and William Edward
