Elias Wills of St Stephen's in the County of Cornwall Being sick in body but of perfect mind and memory thanked be god therfore do make and ordaine this my last will and testament in manner and forme following first I bequeath my Soule into the hands of Christ my m̄t full Redemer and Redeemer My body also I command to Christian burial to be interred in the Church yard of Saint Stephen's above said faithfully believynge and being fully assyured that it shall be rayled up agayne at the general Resurrection and that it being then rayled to my Soule I shall be both in body and Soule receaved into everlasting glory Item I give unto the poore of St Stephen's aforesaid Thirtie shillings Item I give to the poore of Lanark xxvi shillings Item I give to the poore of St Germanus ten shillings Item I give to the poore of Quethwicks Ten shillings with Recwell somme of mony my will is that they bee distributed to the obverses of the poore or to the Ministers of the said Recwell parochie to bee distributed in the said parochie according to the distribution of the said Ministers and Cverchers together with some of the honestest and sufficientest men in the said parochie Item I give unto my wifte Joane Wills the Tentment called Wlands with the ppterunys in whch I now live in St Stephen's aforesaid during her owne life if my Sonne Peter Wills late long and the tyme sacrificed in my service of Wlands about said so longe continuall Item I give unto the said Joane my wifte the wholt ptey profit of all my lands in Lanark in Cornwall aforesaid with my selfe there and therwhre until such tyme as my Sonne Peter aforesaid shall haue attayned to the age of thre and twenty yeare the said yearlye profits and rents aforesaid being by her to bee enjoyed till that tyme for the better enablynge of her towards the maintenance of my Daughters and of raising of thire psonal herafter mentioned as affect towards the maintenance of my Sonne Peter both in the Country and at Oxford when he shalbe fit and able to go therunto Item I give unto my Sonne Peter Wills aforesaid the remainder of Wlands with the ppterunys aforesaid after my said wifte mothes death if she survive her during his owne naturall life Item I give unto the said Peter my Sonne all my lands in Lanark with all my rents aforesaid to bee possessed and enjoyed by him as soone as he shall attayned the age of thre and twenty yeare Item I give unto him my said Sonne my great Godesse ptey of plate of Silver girt as affect my great white Silver drinking bole Item I give unto him my said Sonne my great Signet Ring whch was sonne to me mine owne father as by whch gift I myselfe had it Item I give unto my two daughters Elizabeth and Joane Wills to each of them thre hundred pounds a ptey to whch three hundred pounds to be paid to my said Daughter Elizabeth as soon as she shall haue attayned the age of thretye yeare and other thre hundred pound to be payed to my said Daughter Joane as soon as she shall haue attayned the age of thretye yeare And if it shall haþen that either of them dye before they come to yage my will is that the whole psonon by this my will bequeathed to her be dyng shall be given to the Survivors to whch three hundred pounds in manner and as before set downe Item I give unto my mother
