

and departure from hence do now make and declare my last will and testament first & bequeath my soule to God my Creator assuredly believinge that through the merite of our Christ Jesus I shall have life eternall And I will my body to the earth to be buried in a decent manner in the day forme with as little cost and charge as may be in the parish or Church of Leadgate or Stfoster in Foster lane in London where I now live And as concerning the disposing of my worldie goodes those deale which I owe to other men or being first paid the remaynder thereof I give and bequeath the same as followeth that is to say to my sonne Robert Weddell my geue to him Three hundred pounds currant money of England And to my daughter Anne Weddell my geue to her Two hundred & fifti pounds currant money of England And to my daughter Marie Weddell my geue to her the sume of Two hundred pounds currant money of England But and if it shall happen that any one of these children shall dye and departe this naturall life before they be married or come to age then my will is that the decreased partes parte shall be diuided equally betwixt the other two children that are then living And secondly my will is that if it shall happen that one of those two children that be last living shall dye and departe this life before they be married or come to age that then the deceased partes parte shall be diuided equally betwixt my beloved wife and that child which was shall then be living And lastly if it shall happen that that child shall dy also before it be married or come to age and none of the children be living then that child portion shall also be geuen to my beloved wife And further my will is that shew bee yearely my very good father Senior the sume of Three pounds of currant money And also to my good mother Senior the sume of Three pounds of currant money And also to my brother Robert Senior the sume of fortie shillings provided nevertheless always that the debt whiche he oweth me be payed first But if the debt be not payed Then forgiue him the debt in stede of the forty shillings And to my brother John or Senior the sume of fortie shillings And to my mother Weddell of York the sume of Three pounds of currant money and to my sister Baturie Smith the sume of a fortie shilling And to my sister Sara Weddell the sume of Twenty And to my chosen William Weddells daughter Jane Weddell my goddaughter the sume of Twenty shillings And to my chosen Anne Morris the sume of Three pounds currant money And last of all I geue to my beloved wife Sara Weddell whome I make my absolute and sole Executrix all the residue of my worldie goodes & estate both landes & goodes chattells and ready moneye and euerthing else what soever dolt or may belong unto me And I doe make my Father Robert Senior my Executor This is my last will & testament dated this fifth day of July 1636 In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal before Thomas Weddell witnesse to this will & suarant his style William Stratford Jams Gill.

to Almighty God to make and do by me this my last will and testament in manner and forme followinge first yene and bequeath my soule to Almighty God my Mafter & Creator, and to Jesus Christ his onlie begotten sonne my onely Saviour & Redemer, & hoping my and trusting through the merite of his bether death and passion and innocent shedding of his most pretious bloud to haue remission & forgenesse of all my sinnes by no meanes or merite of any Angell or Saint what soeuer. And my body to be buried in the earth from whence it came at the discretion of my Executors Item yene and bequeath to the poore people of Dring and Willesthorne ffiftie shillings of currant English money to be payed within one yere next after my decease Item yene & bequeath unto my daughter ffisher the summe of Thirtie poundes of currant English money to be payd her within one yere next after my decease Item yene bequeath unto my sonne William Lake the summe of Thirtie poundes of currant English money to be payd him within one yere next after my decease Item yene and bequeath unto Anne ffisher my grandchild the summe of Ten poundes of currant English money to be payd her either at the day of her marriage or at the age of one and twenty yeres whiche of them shall first happen Item yene and bequeath all that my house called Ellionars situate in Dinsley within the said parish of us greater Dring in the said County of Hertford, and all my free landes meadowes & pastures with the maintenance thereto belonging. And all my other free landes lying within the County of Hertford to my daughter Anne Chroftmerton for the time of her naturall life. And after her decease to the first sonne of her body lawfully begotten and to the heirs of the body of such first sonne lawfully begotten. And for a fault of such issue then to the heirs of the body of my said daughter Chroftmerton. And if she happen to dy without issue then I give & bequeath all my said house and landes with the maintenance aforesaid to my daughter ffisher and to the heirs of her body lawfully begotten. And if she happen to dy without issue then I will that my said house and landes shall remaine & goe to the right heirs of me the said Thomas Lake forever. All the rest of my goodes & bequeath all my debt being payd and my funerall expences discharged. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anne Chroftmerton, whom I make my sole Executrix of this my last will and testament. And all former wills and testaments by me made & otherwhise revokē and disallowē by these presents In witness whereof the said Thomas Lake to this my present last will and testament hanc exulto & implichā & seal the day & yere first above written yee me Thomas Lake.
