This will was proved at Londony Eighteenth day of the Month of November in the year of our Lord God One Thousand six hundred fiftie and seven before the Judges for probate of wills and granting Administration lawfully authorized by the oath of *Gertrude Robins* the Relict and sole and only Executrix named in the above written last will and Testament of the deceased to whom Administration of all and singular the Goods Chattells and debts of the said deceased was granted and committed the being first legally sworn by virtue of a Commission truly and faithfully to administer the same ...

In the name of God Amen *John Lake*

on the Eight and Twentieth day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand six hundred sixty nine *John Lake* of the parish of *Stutterley* in the County of *Derby* being weak and sick of Body but in perfect memory praised to God God ordained and made this my present Testament Concerning here in my last will in manner and forme following In presence of *Commend* my Soule into the hands of Almighty God my Maker and my Body to the Earth from whence it came in full hope of Resurrection And Concerning my Temporall Estate where with it hath pleased God to endue me in this my pilgrimage on Earth I dispose of as followeth Item I give and bequeath unto *Humphrey Yeomarott Henry Yeomarott Betornott Yeomarott and Sarah Yeomarott* the children of *John Yeomarott* of *Wings Nympton* in the County of *Derby* the full summe of *twentie* shillings to be equally divided betweene them Item I give and bequeath unto *Anthony Wado* and *Wilmott* his wife *six pence* a peece from *Ignis* and bequeath unto *Jocine Rogermes* *six pence* And all the rest of my Goods not given nor bequeathed I give and bequeath unto *Robert Lake* and *Margaret Lake* my Mother and Sister to be equally divided betweene them and they if doe constitute exors and make voynt Exors to this my last will and Testament they paying my debts Legall and funerall expens In witness where of I have hereunto sett my hand and seale *Yeston* the day and yeare above written The signe of *John Lake* Witness hereunto: *John Dymcombe* the signe of *Robt Tanner* ...
