Bucke and that shalld be within the thirde Item I give and bequeath
unto my Cousin William Smale sower Bushells of Rye Item I give
and bequeath unto John Smale daughter of William Smale five pound
of good and lawfull mony of England to be paid when she shalld come
to the age of one and Twentie yeres Item I give and bequeath unto
the wif of William Smale Twentie shillings to each of them
of good and lawfull mony of England to be paid when they come to a
one and Twentie yeres of age and my will and meaning is that if
any or either of them happen to dye before they come to age it shalld remaine

be paid by my Exor. within three yeeres next after my decease Item
I give unto Elizabeth the wife of Thomas Wyplewman Town shillings to be paid
by my Exor. within three yeeres next after my decease And of the
rest of my goods I doe make my wife Cecily Leigh whole Exor. And
I shall desire Thomas Leigh of Tiverton Town and William Leigh of
Wyplewman the somme of Robert Leigh to be my Ruler to see that my wife
receives And I doe give unto them for their service taken thereon one
shilling a yeere to be paid by my Exor. In witness whereof I have
