followng (that is to say) first and principally I give and command my soule
into the handes of Almyghty God my Creatore, and my body to this Earth wherefore
Ie have by this voluntarie record in writing willed my selfe to John Salt and Richard Salt
and by my selfe I have made my present Will ioyntly and decessively
of giving decessively and biqually unto my sonnes John Salt and Richard Salt
and to my suster Anne Lupton wife of Edward the sonne of Edward
Lupton citizen of London in the shire of Lancashire dwelling at
Lancaster in the shire of Lancashire, her seuer to be paid there
shortly by me. And witness thereto in hand my self named John Lupton by Almyghty
God and by these presentes for the remaing of mytale goodes ready monys
all chyd my pecuniall Estate voluntarierly giving decessively and biqually to my
sonnes Edward and Harry Salt. To John Lupton for mytale monys appayled
and ordynments to be mytale sonnes and sonnes executrix of this my last Will & Testament
and if he shal by alms fearely made tiller by devyting or by good
merchandise to be taken for mytale last Will and Testament and now
hereby witness thereto. If this said Deed shall be helde to this my present Will
sett to bothe sides and sealed this day and yere first abobe written (this
is) Signed sealed published and declared to be this last Will and Testament of
me and Edward Lupton Testator in the presence of Geo: Mardon, John Adams /
