 and principally I commit my soule into the hands of Almighty God that gave
 it me Trusting and assuredly hoping to receive Eternall Salvation in the
 great and terrible day of the coming of the Lord Jesus And my body I commit
 to the Sea in case I shall dye or be slain before the said Expedition shall be
 accomplished or otherwise to be decently interred attording to the direction
 of my Executors hereafter named And for that portion of Temporall Estate
 which it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me whether I shall or
 personall mouny Plate Jewells household stuffe goods houses debts (creditt)
 lands or Tenements I give and bequeath unto my deare and loving wife
 Martha Lake And I make and declare my said loving wife Martha Lake
 the full and sole Executrix of my last will and Testament And I desire my
 two good friends M: Giles Bullerke and M: Samuell Curtis to be Overseers
 of this my last will and Testament Earnestly desiring them to be ayding and
 assisting to my said Executrix in the due Execution thereof And I doe
 hereby give and grant unto my said Executrix full power and Lawfull au-
 thority (for non payment of any sume or sumes of mouny debts or Creditts
 as shalbe due and payab: to me att the tyme of my decease) the severall
 person and persons from whom such sume or sumes of mouny debts or Creditts
 shalbe due and payab: as aforesaid To sue arrears implead imprison and out

 them to Comente and prosecute And upon any recovery receipt or agreement
 of or for any thing sume or sumes of money debts or Credits due to me as aforesaid
 The Receipt or acquittance of my said Executors shall be a sufficient discharge
 And if the said John Salt doe hereby for me and in my name and to my owne
 proper use and behoofe authorize my said loving wife Martha Salt to use
 all such lawfull wayes and meanes for the recovery and retaining of all and every
 such sume and sumes of money debts and Credits as aforesaid as fully and largely
 in every respect and thing as the Lawes of this Realme will the same permit
 and suffer And I doe hereby Revoke and disannull all former wills and Testa-
 ments by me heretofore made And now make and declare this my present last
 will and Testament In witness whereof I have to this my last will and Testa-
 ment sett my hand and Seal the thirteyn and Twentieth day of April
 Anno Domini 1672 And in the ffourth and Twentieth year of the Reigne of our
 Sovereign Lord Charles the Second by the grace of God of England Scotland
 France and Ireland King defender of the faith etc. John Salt, Signed
 Sealed published and declared by the said Testator as and for his last will and Testament
 on the thirteyn and Twentieth day of April 1672 above written in the presence of us
