thought good to make & set downe my last will and Testament in writing as followeth
(vixit, first & bequeath my soule to Almightie god my Creator hoping that through
the onely merite of his deare sonne my lord and Savour Jesus Christ my Redeemer
hee will receave the same into his gloriouse Kingdome. And my body & bequeath) to the
earth to bee buried at the direction of my Exerutrix hereafter to bee named Item &
give and bequeath) unto my sonne Thomas Cawton the summe of one hundred pounds
of good & lawfull money of England and the same to bee paid unto him when he
shall come to the full age of one (21) twenty yeare And the same in the meane tym
my will is shall bee remaine in his mothers hands, or at her disposing, for the good
of my said sonne Item & give and bequeath) to my good friend Christopher Grot
my blanke suite with the Cassim late on it, and a blanke robe with a cassim late
about it. Item & give to my friend Miles Hart tennet shillings to buy hym a paire
of gloues, and to his wife five shillings to buy her a paire of gloues. And all the rest
of that poore wortly estate whiche it hath pleased God to send mee, not assyndit a
disposid of, & give and bequeath) to my loving wife Agnes Cawton inhouse. I make
no Exerutrix of this my last will & Testament In witness wheresoever I haue heretounto
set my hand & seal, & published the same to bee my last will and Testament this
day and yere abovesaid. John Cawton. Signed sealed & published in the presence
