Descendants of Daniel Everitt

Generation 1

Daniel¹ Everitt. He died in 1807. He married Rachel Howell.

Notes for Daniel Everitt:

The Daniel Everitt who married Rachel and who died 1807 might be the Daniel Everitt listed for a book debt in the Accounts section of the Last Will and Testament of John Everitt of Bethlehem Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, written 29 May 1756 and proved 12 Jul 1761 (NJ State Archives: 527J). It is likely Daniel was related to John Everitt, but it is not known how. The identity of Daniel's wife, Rachel is also unknown, but she may have been the daughter of Joseph Howell of Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, whose Last Will and Testament, written 11 May 1773 and proved 23 Sep 1774, names, among others, a daughter Rachel Everitt (Honeyman, "Calendar of Wills: 1771-1780," p.259).

The Last Will and Testament of Daniel Everitt, written 30 Oct 1804 and proved 28 Oct 1807, locates Daniel in Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ and names wife Rachel, and children Daniel, Moses, Mary (wife of John Lake), Rachel (wife of Darius Everitt), Sarah (wife of Cornelius Coolbough), and Elizabeth (wife of John Kemple). Witnesses were Jonathan Roberson, Joshua Opdycke, and Richard Opdycke, Jr. Executors were Richard Opdycke, Esq. and Thomas Lequear (NJ State Archives, 2248J).

Daniel Everitt's property is surely that mentioned in the 1766 mortgage deeds of Joseph Everitt, who was John Everitt's son (Bk.1, pp.17-19). Joseph's land bordered Richard Opdike, Malakiah Bonham, Abraham Gray (Daniel Everitt made the 1782 Inventory for Abraham Gray), and Thomas Herbert (deacon of the Kingwood Baptist Church). Further, Richard Opdycke and Daniel Everitt were witnesses to the 3 May 1803 deed transferring part of the Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ property of Ezekiel Everitt (John Everitt's grandson), then of Middletown Twp., Bucks Co., PA, to Francis Robinson (Bk.14, p.281). Also, records of the Kingwood Baptist Church contain a 3 May 1790 entry for the exclusion of Richard Opdyke, and Dan'l Everitt and Rachel Everitt (D'Autrechy, "Some Records of Old Hunterdon County: 1701-1838," p.90). It should also be noted that Daniel and Rachel Everitt's son, Moses, married Hannah Rittenhouse and in 1815 Moses purchased property form Cornelius Polhemus, becoming involved in law suits filed in the 1820s by the heirs of Cornelius Polhemus. (A witness to the 1756 Last Will and Testament of John Everitt was a Cornelius Polhemus.)

For further research, on 29 Jul 1815, the Surrogate of Hunterdon Co., NJ, J. T. Blackwell, recorded that the Orphans Court appointed Ezekiel Everitt guardian of the persons and estates of Elizabeth, Rachel, Asa, and Sally Ann Everitt. The children's names more closely match those of Daniel and Rachel Everitt than any other Everitt family. After Daniel Everitt's death, Rachel may have married John Price on 19 Jun 1811.

Notes for Rachel Howell:

For further research, after the 1807 death of Daniel Everitt, Rachel may have remarried John Price on 19 Jun 1811. The marriage record states they were both from Bethlehem Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ.

Rachel was presumably the daughter of Joseph Howell, who, in his Last Will and Testament written 29 Dec 1773 and proved 23 Sep 1774, names daughter Rachel Everitt. Also named were wife Gartrude, son Daniel, and other daughters: Anna Smalley, Syndony Pettit, Jemima Reeder, and Phebe Garner. Executors were Daniel Howell, son of deceased son Daniel Howell, and William Rettinghouse. Witnesses were John Sutton, Samuel Hall, and Uriah Bonham. The 15 Sep 1774 Inventory was made by Uriah Bonham and William Hoogland. The 15 Dec 1791 Account was by the surviving executor, William Rettinghouse, and Reading Howell, administrator of Daniel Howell, deceased executor of Joseph Howell. Legacies were paid to Anne Smalley, John Pettit, Daniel Howell, Rachel Everitt, Jemima Reeder, and Phebe Garner. (Lib.17, p.99)

Sources state Joseph Howell's first wife, and the mother of the children named in his will, was Gertrude Emma Burroughs. Joseph's second wife was Gartrude Goodwin, who first married Theodorus Hall on 29 Apr 1729 at Christ Church, Philadelphia, PA. Theodorus died in a boating accident on the Delaware River at Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ in 1759, and Gartrude Hall was appointed administrator of his estate, with fellow bondsman Joseph Howell (Lib.9, p.454). Gratrude Howell died 1805. Her Last Will and Testament, written 27 Feb 1788 and proved 5 Feb 1805, identifies her as the widow of Joseph Howell and mother of Jacob Hall, Jesse Hall, Samuel

Hall, Mary Lake, Gartrude Opdycke, Susanna Fox, Rebecca Richards, and Elizabeth Hall. Witnesses were Samuel Davis and Uriah Bonham (2147 J).

Marshall Lake writes that "There is a John LAKE (c1745-1834 Burlington Co, NJ) who married Mary HALL (c1745-after 1839 probably Burlington Co) c1778 in Kingwood Twp. The only child I know for them is Elisabeth (b c1780). I'm not aware of the parentage for this John LAKE. In a pension file for John LAKE there is a mention of an unnamed sister living in an adjoining county in NJ (probably Hunterdon). According to Snell, Mary HALL is the daughter of Theodore HALL & Gertrude GORDON (married 1729), and John & Mary lived in Kingwood many years. (According to my research they show up in Burlington Co by1818.) According to Marfy Goodspeed (a Delaware Twp, Hunterdon Co Historian) Luther OPDYKE married first Gertrude HALL, daughter of Theodore HALL and Gerturde GORDON, making Mary HALL & Gertrude HALL sisters."

Uriah Bonham (1724-1809) had a grandson, Uriah Bonham (1791-1859), who in 1818 married Elizabeth Everitt, daughter of Ezekiel Everitt (1746-1829) and Mary (d.1768). Grandson Uriah Bonham was the son of Amos Bonham (1752-1817) and Rebecca Rittenhouse (1758-1830), daughter of William Rittenhouse.

Daniel Everitt and Rachel Howell had the following children:

i. DANIEL² EVERITT. He died on 05 Aug 1818 in Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. He married Sarah L. Hartpence, daughter of Johannes Eberhart Pence and Hannah Kitchen, on 11 Jun 1795. She was born on 29 Mar 1775 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 24 Oct 1836 in Trenton, Mercer Co., NJ (Old School Baptist Cemetery, Locktown, Hunterdon Co., NJ).

Notes for Daniel Everitt:

Daniel and Sarah had no children. In his Last Will and Testament, written 19 Oct 1815 and proved 29 Aug 1818, Daniel Evritt of Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ names wife Sarah, nephew John Hartpence (son of Thomas Hartpence), Uzenia Potts, Negro man Tom, Daniel Evritt Hartpence (son of James Hartpence), Daniel Evritt Coolbough (son of Cornelious Coolbough). Daniel also makes bequests to "the surviving children of each of my four sisters": Mary Lake, Rachel Evritt (deceased), Sarah Coolbough, and Elizabeth Kemple (Wills, Vol. 3-6: 1815-1838).

Notes for Sarah L. Hartpence:

The Last Will and Testament of John Eberhart-Pence of Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, written 22 Sep 1801 and proved 8 Oct 1801, names wife Hannah, sons Benjamin, James, Thomas, and Kitchen, and grandson John Case. Executors were son James Hartpence and son-in-law Daniel Everet (Lib.39, p.404).

After the death of Daniel Everitt, Sarah married Thomas Lequear (1762-1846) on 18 Sep 1819 (Rev. David Bateman).

- 2. ii. Moses Everitt. He died on 12 Aug 1851 in Kalamazoo Co., MI (Mountain Home Cemetery, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo Co., MI). He married Hannah Rittenhouse. She was born in 1783. She died on 22 Aug 1839 in Kalamazoo Co., MI (Mountain Home Cemetery, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo Co., MI).
 - iii. Mary Everitt. She married John Lake.

Notes for John Lake:

Offered here for further research is circumstantial evidence that the John Lake who married Mary Everitt was the son of John Lake who died intestate in 1808 in Alexandria Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. A Letter of Administration dated 14 Apr 1808 granted administration of John Lake's estate to Luther Opdycke, Esq., with sureties of John Taylor and Zenas Lake. A 29 Apr 1808 Inventory of that estate was made by James Larason and James Mettler, sworn to by Luther Opdycke on 4 May 1808 (NJ State Archives 2319 J).

Tax records for Bucks Co., PA list a John Lake in Solebury Twp. from 1798 to 1804 who owned 100 acres and then 235 acres by 1803. He may be the same

John Lake of the 1800 Solebury Twp. census with 1M 26-44, 1F 26-44, 1M under 10, and 2F under 10. Around 1804, John Lake may have moved from Bucks Co., PA to Hunterdon Co., NJ and died there in 1808. He seems to have had at least three sons: John, Reuben, and Zenas.

Bucks Co. tax records again begin listing a John Lake as well as a Reuben Lake from 1827 to 1837. The 1830 Plumstead Twp. (adjoining Solebury), Bucks Co., PA census lists a John Lake with 1M 30-40, 1F 20-30, 1M 0-5, 1M 5-10, 2M 10-15, 1F 0-5, 1F 10-15. Reuben Lake appears as Rubin Lake on the 1810 Solebury Twp. census with 1M 45+, 1F 26-44, 2M 16-25, and 1F 16-25. He is Ruben Lake in 1820 in Solebury Twp. with 1M 45+ and 1M under 10.

Sources state that the John Lake who died 1808 had son Zenas Lake, born 1 Feb 1770 in Hunterdon Co., NJ and died 17 May 1842 in Marion Co., IN. He married Mary Hartpence, born 14 Jan 1770 in Hunterdon Co., NJ and died 17 Feb 1835 in Marion Co., IN. Mary was the daughter of Johannes Eberhart Pence (1734-1818) and Hannah Kitchen (1742-1818). In his Last Will and Testament, written 22 Sep 1801 and proved 8 Oct 1801, John Eberhart-Pence of Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, names family members including son-in-law Daniel Everet (Lib.39, p.404). Daniel Everitt married Sarah Hartpence (1775-1836).

Another matter of note is that the Last Will and Testament of John Everitt of Bethlehem Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, written 29 May 1756 and proved 12 Jul 1761, names, among others, three legatees, one of whom was John Lake. He may have married one of John's daughters. Further, one of the people who made the Inventory was Daniel Lake (Lib.11, p.465 / Lib.13, p.439). The Last Will and Testament of a Daniel Lake of Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, written 25 Sep 1775 and proved 8 Nov 1775, names his children, including son John Lake (Lib.17, p.255).

iv. RACHEL EVERITT. She died before 1815. She married DARIUS EVERITT. He died in 1822

Notes for Darius Everitt:

Tax records place Darius Everitt in Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ from 1778 to 1780. The following year, 1781, Bucks Co., PA tax records list Darius (and his brother, Ezekiel) as living in Tinicum Twp. (Each is listed as Everhart.) The same records show that Darius moved to Upper Makefield Twp. between 1784 and 1785. Darius Everitt's first census appearance is on the 1790 Bucks Co., PA census, where he appears as Darius Everard. His household contains 8 members: 2M 16+, 4M -16, and 2F. This number of household members suggests two families. The identity of the other family is unknown. The possibility exists, however, that Darius's father, John, may have been living with Darius. John Everitt died 1808 in Kingwood Twp. The other possibility is that Darius's father-in-law was living with him. (None of Darius's known sons would have been married by 1790.)

On 15 Apr 1794, Darius Everitt purchased 150 acres of land in Amwell Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, from Isaiah and Miriam Quimby. The deed (Bk.11, p.326) describes Darius as formerly of Bucks Co., PA, but at the time of the sale as of Amwell Twp. A witness to the deed was Ezekiel Everitt, surely Darius's brother.

Later deeds identify Darius's wife as Rachel, as do other documents. Rachel was the daughter of Daniel and Rachel Everitt, and may have been Darius's cousin. Rachel died before 1815, and Darius remarried Sarah (Pettit) Kelley on 18 May 1816. (Sarah's first marriage was to Daniel Kelley on 5 Oct 1797. Daniel Kelley died 1814.) The marriage was announced in the 27 May 1816 edition of the "True American": "On the 18th Instant by John Cavanaugh, esq., Mr. Darius Everitt to Mrs. Sarah Kelly, all of Amwell" (p.3).

Darius Everitt's Last Will and Testament, written 8 Jul 1821 and proved 22 Jun 1822, states he resided in Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ and identifies his wife as Sarah, and his children as Ezekiel, Daniel, Asa, Enos, Moses, Sarah, Fanny, and Elizabeth. Darius writes that the "most considerable part of my Real estate lies in the county of hampshire in the State of Virginia," and states that he

owned two adjacent tracts of land, one consisting of 500 acres and the second of 214 acres. Darius indicates that Asa, Enos, and Moses were living on this Virginia land, and then directs that the land be divided and given to his three sons. To his wife Sarah, Darius gave his Kingwood Twp. real estate, consisting of 90 acres. Sons Ezekiel and Daniel were given only \$1.00 each, for they had earlier received money from their father. Darius's daughter, Sarah, was "infirm" and money was to be set aside for her "decent support during her natural life." The estate left to Darius's wife would be shared with his daughters. Three executors were named: sons Ezekiel and Daniel, and George Wanamaker (Bk.4, p.1).

Darius's wife, Sarah, died 1841, and the Court granted administration of Darius's estate to George Wanamaker. Citing Darius's Will, the Court ruled that the estate was to be sold after his wife Sarah's death. And since Ezekiel Everitt and Daniel Everitt were no longer residing in NJ, the sale was to be conducted by Darius's third appointed executor, George Wanamaker. The Letter of Administration states that Sarah Everitt was "late of the County of Miami in Ohio" (Bk.4, p.58). Apparently, at some point Sarah moved to Ohio to live with her son, Daniel, who was living in Miami Co., OH. Daniel married Rachel Pettit. If and how Sarah and Rachel were related is unknown. George Wanamaker, who had married Darius's daughter, Fanny, sold Darius's estate to William Hann on 2 May 1843 (Bk.80, p.324).

For a history of this family, see the separate report, "Descendants of Darius Everitt."

- 3. v. SARAH EVERITT was born on 30 Apr 1782. She married CORNELIUS COOLBAUGH. He was born on 19 Nov 1762 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on 22 Sep 1841 in Bradford Co., PA.
 - vi. ELIZABETH EVERITT. She married JOHN KEMPLE.

2. **Moses**² **Everitt** (Daniel¹). He died on 12 Aug 1851 in Kalamazoo Co., MI (Mountain Home Cemetery, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo Co., MI). He married **Hannah Rittenhouse**. She was born in 1783. She died on 22 Aug 1839 in Kalamazoo Co., MI (Mountain Home Cemetery, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo Co., MI).

Notes for Moses Everitt:

Tentaively entered here as the Moses Everitt who married Hannah Rittenhouse is the 84 year-old Moses Everett, born in NJ, and in 1850 living in Alamo, Kalamazoo Co., MI. He resided with his son and daughter-in-law, Mahlon and Margaret Everett, and their children. Mahlon was born in NJ and Margaret in PA, and their children in MI. Margaret was the daughter of George Bennett and Martha Torbert of Newtown, Bucks Co., PA. Moses (d.1851) is buried with wife Hannah (1783-1839) in the Mountain Home Cemetery, Kalamazoo, Kalamazoo Co., MI. (Sources state Hannah Rittenhouse was born 1784.)

Notes for Hannah Rittenhouse:

As histories of the Rittenhouse family demonstrate, the Rittenhouses had close ties to the Everitts. Hannah Rittenhouse's father, Joseph, was the son of Lott Rittenhouse and Hannah Higgins. Lott's brother, William, married Rebecca Harned, and their daughter, Rebecca, married Amos Bonham. Amos and Rebecca Bonham's son, Uriah, married Elizabeth Everitt, daughter of Ezekiel and Mary Everitt. Amos and Rebecca Bonham's son, Ambrose, married Anna Lair, and their son, John Bonham, married Rebecca Everitt, daughter of Ezekiel and Catherine Everitt.

William and Rebecca Rittenhouse's son, Daniel, married Jane Cartright, and their daughter, Catherine, married Ezekiel Everitt Jr., son of Ezekiel and Mary Everitt.

William and Rebecca Rittenhouse's son, Benjamin, married Elizabeth Fowler, and their son, William, married Sarah Emans and had a daughter, Nancy Ann, who married Epenetus Everitt, the grandson of Ezekiel and Mary Everitt. Benjamin and Elizabeth's son, Nathaniel, married Nancy Thatcher, and their daughter, Margaret, married Elijah Everitt.

Data entered here for Cornelius and Sarah Coolbaugh come principally from Edward Coolbaugh Hoagland's 1938 "The Coolbaugh Family in America" (pp.16-17, 23).
