# Descendants of Darius Everitt

### Generation No. 1

**1.** DARIUS<sup>1</sup> EVERITT died 1822. He married (1) RACHEL EVERITT, daughter of DANIEL EVERITT and RACHEL. He married (2) SARAH PETTIT KELLEY 18 May 1816.

## Notes for DARIUS EVERITT:

Tax records place Darius Everitt in Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ from 1778 to 1780. The following year, 1781, Bucks Co., PA tax records list Darius (and his brother, Ezekiel) as living in Tinicum Twp. (Each is listed as Everhart.) The same records show that Darius moved to Upper Makefield Twp. between 1784 and 1785. Darius Everitt's first census appearance is on the 1790 Bucks Co., PA census, where he appears as Darius Everard. His household contains 8 members: 2M 16+, 4M -16, and 2F. This number of household members suggests two families. The identity of the other family is unknown. The possibility exists, however, that Darius's father, John, may have been living with Darius. John Everitt died 1808 in Kingwood Twp. The other possibility is that Darius's father-in-law was living with him. (None of Darius's known sons would have been married by 1790.)

On 15 Apr 1794, Darius Everitt purchased 150 acres of land in Amwell Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, from Isaiah and Miriam Quimby. The deed (Bk.11, p.326) describes Darius as formerly of Bucks Co., PA, but at the time of the sale as of Amwell Twp. A witness to the deed was Ezekiel Everitt, surely Darius's brother.

Later deeds identify Darius's wife as Rachel, as do other documents. Rachel was the daughter of Daniel and Rachel Everitt, and may have been Darius's cousin. Rachel presumably died before 1816, for Darius remarried Sarah (Pettit) Kelley on 18 May 1816. (Sarah's first marriage was to Daniel Kelley on 5 Oct 1797. Daniel Kelley died 1814.) The marriage was announced in the 27 May 1816 edition of the "True American": "On the 18th Instant by John Cavanaugh, esq., Mr. Darius Everitt to Mrs. Sarah Kelly, all of Amwell" (p.3).

Darius Everitt's Last Will and Testament was written 8 Jul 1821 and proved 22 Jun 1822. Darius, residing in Kingwood Twp., identifies his wife as Sarah, and his children as Ezekiel, Daniel, Asa, Enos, Moses, Sarah, Fanny, and Elizabeth. Darius writes that the "most considerable part of my Real estate lies in the county of hampshire in the State of Virginia," and states that he owned two adjacent tracts of land, one consisting of 500 acres and the second of 214 acres. Darius indicates that Asa, Enos, and Moses were living on this Virginia land, and then directs that the land be divided and given to his three sons. To his wife Sarah, Darius gave his Kingwood Twp. real estate, consisting of 90 acres. Sons Ezekiel and Daniel were given only \$1.00 each, for they had earlier received money from their father. Darius's daughter, Sarah, was "infirm" and money was to be set aside for her "decent support during her natural life." The estate left to Darius's wife would be shared with his daughters. Three executors were named: sons Ezekiel and Daniel, and George Wanamaker (Bk.4, p.1).

Darius's wife, Sarah, died 1841, and the Court granted administration of Darius's estate to George Wanamaker. Citing Darius's Will, the Court ruled that the estate was to be sold after his wife Sarah's death. And since Ezekiel Everitt and Daniel Everitt were no longer residing in NJ, the sale was to be conducted by Darius's third appointed executor, George Wanamaker. The Letter of Administration states that Sarah Everitt was "late of the County of Miami in Ohio" (Bk.4, p.58). Apparently, at some point Sarah moved to Ohio to live with her son, Daniel, who was living in Miami Co., OH. Daniel married Rachel Pettit. If and how Sarah and Rachel were related is unknown. George Wanamaker, who had married Darius's daughter, Fanny, sold Darius's estate to William Hann on 2 May 1843 (Bk.80, p.324).

The following history of this Everitt family is based on sources such as wills, deeds, cemetery records, census reports, family documents, vital records, and, especially for the West Virginia branches, the "West Virginia Vital Research Records" at www.wvculture.org.

#### Generation No. 2

**2.** EZEKIEL<sup>2</sup> EVERITT (*DARIUS*<sup>1</sup>) was born 06 Nov 1780, and died 20 Jan 1860 in OH. He married (1) CHARITY REED 14 Apr 1805 in the Kingwood Baptist Church (Rev. Garner A. Hunt). She was born 13 Dec 1780, and died 29 Jan 1815. He married (2) MARY WEGGINS 24 Nov 1815. She was born 08 Feb 1790.

### Notes for EZEKIEL EVERITT:

Pennsylvania deeds place Ezekiel Everitt in Tinicum Twp., Bucks Co., PA. Between 1830 and 1840, Ezekiel moved to Swan Twp., Hocking Co., OH. With him in OH was his second wife, Mary Weggins, whom Ezekiel married in 1815.

In a 1940 letter to Hiram E. Deats, Kate Reed Willis, a descendant of Thomas and Rachel Porter, wrote that "Rachel was given a sum of money by a Wanamaker, I think a small legacy, to take to her father Ezekiel Everitt." George Wanamker, one of the executors of Darius Everitt, upon the death of Darius's wife, Sarah, sold the Kingwood Twp. Everitt estate. It is surely the result of this sale that Darius's son, Ezekiel, received the "small legacy." Kate Reed Willis's letter included family data copied from an 8 Apr 1862 letter written by William L. Everitt of South Bloomingville, Hocking Co., OH, to Rachel Everitt Porter, his half-sister. Willis added the 12 Apr 1840 marriage date of Rachel and Thomas. Hocking Co. marriage records state Thomas and Rachel were married 12 Apr 1841. The 19 year-old William Porter and 16 year-old Thomas Porter living with Thomas and Rachel in 1850 could not, then, be their children. They are, perhaps, relatives or children from a possible earlier marriage of Thomas's.

### Notes for JACOB EVERITT:

The death record for Jacob Everett states he died at age 64y3m10d in Hampshire Co., was married to Rebecca, and was the son of Asa and Margt. Everitte. The informant for the record was Derias Everitte, identified as Jacob's brother. Jacob's birth date has been calculated from this data.

#### Notes for ENOS EVERITT:

The Hampshire Co., VA, marriage record of Enos Everitt and Sarah Pettit identifies Sarah's father as Moses Pettit. The 1850 Hampshire census shows Enos and Sarah with children Elizabeth and Lyndona. Living with Enos and Sarah was Sarah's mother, 83 year-old Lyndona Pettit, then a widow, for Moses Pettit died 1846. Living next to Enos was Asa Everitt's son, Darius, and his family.

### Notes for Moses Everitt:

The 20 Aug 1810 edition of the "True American" announced, "At Amwell, on the 11th Ins. by Peter Fisher, esq. Mr. Moses Everitt to Miss Hetty Ent, both of the same place" (p.3).

The 1830 Hampshire Co., VA, census lists Moses Everett with four males between the ages of 0 and 15, and four females between 0 and 20. Moses was 50-60 and his wife 40-50. Moses was married in 1810 in NJ, and presumably some of his children were born there. The identity of Moses' eight children is not yet known. Moses died 1837 and the 1840 census lists Hester Everett with 4 males between 10 and 30, and three females between 10 and 30. Hester (no doubt Hetea) was 50-60.

Moses died intestate in 1837, and the Court of Hunterdon Co., NJ, stating that Moses was "late of the State of Virginia," granted administration of his estate to Daniel Ent of Hunterdon Co. on 25 Mar 1837 (3.347). (Surrogate Court records confusingly combine documents of two different Moses Everitts. The other Moses died 1821 and was the son of Ezekiel and Mary Everitt. Coincidentally, this Moses' son, Elijah, petitioned the Court in 1837 regarding his late father's estate.)

Charles Everett and Moses Everett are entered here as children of Moses and Hetea only on the basis of circumstantial evidence. The 1850 Hampshire Co. census lists Charles Everett (34), Amelia (39), Moses (21), John (10), and Harriet (4). Moses was probably Charles's brother. The birth years for Charles and Moses would fit the census records for Moses and Hetea.

## Notes for MOSES EVERITT:

Census records place Moses and Mary Everett in Piedmont Twp. and indicate Moses worked for the railroad. The 1880 census identifies Mary as Moses' wife and states Moses was born in VA and his parents in NJ. The death record for Moses states he died at age 66y in Mineral Co., WV. His occupation was a "conductor." The informant for the record was Mrs. Dyke.

### Notes for MARY S.:

The death record for Mrs. Everett states she was the spouse of Moses Everett and died at the age of about 60y. The record states she was a widow, though Moses' death record gives an 1896 date for his death.

**6.** FANNY<sup>2</sup> EVERITT (*DARIUS*<sup>1</sup>) was born 17 Mar 1800, and died 12 Aug 1855. She married GEORGE WANAMAKER 08 Oct 1820. He died 26 Oct 1877.

## Notes for FANNY EVERITT:

The 17 Oct 1855 issue of the "Hunterdon County Democrat" noted the death of Fanny E. Wanamaker, wife of George Wanamaker, and stated she died at age 55y4m26d "after a long and protracted illness." The death record for F. E. Wanamaker (Bk.S, p.357) states she died at age 55y. Her parents are not named on the record.

## Notes for GEORGE WANAMAKER:

The 20 Nov 1877 issue of the "Hunterdon County Democrat" noted the death of George Wanamaker and

stated he died in Kingwood Twp. at age 88 years. George Wanamaker's death record (Bk.BF, p.17) states he died at age 78y and was the son of Henry and Mary Wanamaker.

### Notes for JOHN W. WANAMAKER:

The 6 Dec 1887 issue of the "Hunterdon County Democrat" noted the death of Mr. J. W. Wanamaker of Frenchtown on the 29th of November at age 65. John W. Wanamaker's death certificate states that he died at age 65y11m12d in Frenchtown, NJ, and indicates he was married. His parents are not identified on the certificate. John W. Wanamaker's birth date has been calculated from the certificate's information.

## Notes for GEORGE N. WANAMAKER:

The 17 Oct 1855 issue of the "Hunterdon County Democrat" noted the death of George N. Wanamaker, "son of George and Fanny Wanamaker, aged 27 years and 11 months." The same issue noted the death of George's mother, Fanny.

### Notes for MANNING F. WANAMAKER:

The marriage record for M. F. Wanamaker and T. L. Stilwell (Bk.S, p.190) inidicates both were 24 years old and married in NY. M. F. Wanamaker's father is identified as G. Wanamaker and T. S. Stilwell's father as C. Stilwell. By 1870 Manning F. Wanamaker had moved to Elmira, Chamung Co., NY, where he appears on the 1870 census with his wife Sarah. Living with them was a 20 year-old Carson Stowell. Manning and Sarah also appear on the 1880 and 1900 Elmira censuses. The census-taker for the 1900 census indicated that Manning and Sarah had had no children.

## Notes for ELIZABETH EVERITT:

The Lequear papers, housed at the Hunterdon County Historical Society, state Darius Everitt's daughter, Elizabeth, married Samuel Howard and lived in OH. NJ marriage records indicate Elizabeth married in 1835. The family information entered here for Samuel and Elizabeth Howard is based, as yet, only on the circumstantial evidence of census reports. The 1850 New Haven Twp., Huron Co., OH census lists Samuel and Elizabeth Howard, both of whom were born in NJ, with children John E., Sarah M., William E., and Ann E. One son, John E., was born about 1837 in NJ. The other children were born in OH. John E. Howard's marriage date comes from the record of Ohio marriages, and he and his family appear in 1870 in Madison Twp., Richland Co., OH. By 1880, John Howard and family were in Ripley Twp., Huron Co., OH.

## Notes for DANIEL EVERITT:

Correspondence with Barbara Bauer of the Palatines to America National Library, in which she conveyed information about Lindoni / Lyndona Keifer, led to further research about Daniel and Rachel Everitt's children.

The 1850 Milton Twp., Miami Co., OH census lists 66 year-old Daniel Everitt, a carpenter, who was born in NJ. With him was 30 year-old Sarah Hall, born in NJ, and 9 year-old Elizabeth Hall, born in OH. Sarah was

probably Daniel's daughter and the widow of William Hall, for the 1846 Last Will and Testament of William Hall refers to a daughter, Mary Elizabeth Hall, and a brother-in-law, Sylvester Everett. Barbara Bauer wrote that she found a record of Daniel Keifer and Sylvester Everett, both carpenters, suing for a debt owed. The 1850 census shows Sylvester and his family and states he was born in NJ. On the basis of this evidence, Sarah, Lyndona, and Sylvester are entered as children of Daniel and Rachel.

## Notes for THOMAS PORTER:

Thomas and Rachel Porter appear on the 1850 Lee Co., IA census. Apparently, Thomas died before 1860, for Rachel and three of her children are found in Albia, Monroe Co., IA that year. Rachel's daughter, Charity, was also in Albia but living with John M. Porter, who was also born in OH.

(9), and Celia (2). Living with Henry was Nancy Bullard (20). In 1880, Henry Everitt (61), Charlotte (45), and Ellie L. (21) were in Laurelville Twp. living in the household of Lewis (30) and Ema (24) Steel.
