# **Descendants of Jesse Everitt**

#### **Generation 1**

1. **JESSE**<sup>1</sup> **EVERITT** was born on 19 Apr 1775 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on 26 Oct 1845 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. He married **CATHARINE ANN CRAMER**. She was born on 01 Nov 1785 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 03 Jun 1859 in Hunterdon Co., NJ.

#### Notes for Jesse Everitt:

The birth date for Jesse Everitt has been calculated from his tombstone inscription which states he died 26 Oct 1845 at age 70y6m7d.

Jesse Everitt's parents and his relationship to other Lebanon Twp. and Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ Everitts are as yet unknown. On 12 Jun 1819, John and Mary (Apgar) Everitt sold Lebanon Twp. land to John Kreemer, James Ramsey, and Joseph Everitt. The deeds situate the land near Jesse Everitt (Bk.29, pp.603, 626, and 650). Jesse Everitt had apparently moved to Tewksbury Twp., for also on 12 Jun 1819 Jesse and Catharine Everitt of Tewksbury Twp. sold Lebanon Twp. land to John Tiger of Lebanon Twp. The deed states this was the same land purchased by Jesse Everitt from Robert L. Linvingston, situated on the southerly side of a mountain in John Everitt's lot and continuing to land John Everitt sold to James Ramsey (Bk.29, p.520). The 1830 and 1840 Lebanon Twp. censuses list Jesse Everitt. In 1830, the household of Jesse Everitt, 50-60 years old, and a female 40-50 years old, contained four males 10-30 years old and three females 0-30. In 1840, Jesse and his wife's household included two males 20-30, and two females 10-20.

The Last Will and Testament of Jesse Everitt of Lebanon Twp., written 4 Oct 1845 and proved 13 Nov 1845, names his wife, Catharine, and children Elizabeth, John, and Asa. The last two were named executors of his will.

### Notes for Catharine Ann Cramer:

Catharine Everitt's birth date has been calculated from her tombstone inscription which states she died 3 Jun 1859 at age 73y7m2d.

Jesse Everitt and Catharine Ann Cramer had the following children:

- i. JOHN<sup>2</sup> EVERITT was born on 22 Jan 1805 in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on 06 Apr 1889 in Bethlehem Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ (Washington Cemetery, Warren Co., NJ (Sec. BU)). He married Elizabeth Cowell on 19 Nov 1831 in Morris Co., NJ (Rev. H. Whitfield Hunt, Jr.). She was born on 26 Sep 1809. She died on 23 Feb 1879 in Washington Twp., Warren Co., NJ (Washington Cemetery, Warren Co., NJ (Sec. BU)).
- ii. RACHEL EVERITT was born on 07 Jun 1809 in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 05 Mar 1895 in Marksboro, Warren Co., NJ (Marksboro Presbyterian Churchyard, Warren Co., NJ). She married Alexander H. Thomson, son of Robert C. Thomson and Maria Woodruff, on 19 Aug 1830. He was born on 09 Nov 1805 in Marksboro, Frelinghuysen Twp., Warren Co., NJ. He died on 10 Sep 1840 in Warren Co., NJ (Marksboro Presbyterian Churchyard, Warren Co., NJ).
  - iii. MATTHIAS EVERITT was born on 08 Nov 1811 in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on 09 Mar 1894 in Marksboro, Frelinghuysen Twp., Warren Co., NJ (Marksboro Presbyterian Churchyard, Warren Co., NJ).

### Notes for Matthias Everitt:

The death certificate for Matthias Everett states he was born in Hunterdon Co., NJ, the son of Jesse Everett and Catharine Cramer, and resided in Marksboro, Frelinghuysen Twp., Warren Co., NJ, where he died, single, on 9 Mar 1894 at age 82y4m1d. Burial was in Marksboro Cemetery. (1893-94.95.E32)

iv. David Everitt was born on 09 Sep 1815 in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ.

#### Notes for David Everitt:

The 1870 Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists 57 year-old blacksmith, David Everitt. Listed with him were Lina [?] D. Conover (5y), Garret M. Conover (3y), and Mary S. Conover (2y).

# Generation 1 (con't)

v. Asa Everitt was born on 11 May 1817 in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ.

Notes for Asa Everitt:

The 1880 Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ lists 62 year-old Asa Everet boarding with the hotel keeper John N. Lowe and his wife Sarah.

vi. ELIZABETH EVERITT was born in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ.

#### **Generation 2**

2. **JOHN**<sup>2</sup> **EVERITT** (Jesse<sup>1</sup>) was born on 22 Jan 1805 in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on 06 Apr 1889 in Bethlehem Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ (Washington Cemetery, Warren Co., NJ (Sec. BU)). He married Elizabeth Cowell on 19 Nov 1831 in Morris Co., NJ (Rev. H. Whitfield Hunt, Jr.). She was born on 26 Sep 1809. She died on 23 Feb 1879 in Washington Twp., Warren Co., NJ (Washington Cemetery, Warren Co., NJ (Sec. BU)).

Notes for John Everitt:

The 1850 Washington Twp., Morris Co., NJ census lists John and Elizabeth Everitt with children Holloway W., Lydia Ann, and John. In 1870, John and Elizabeth are seen with 22 year-old son John. The 1880 Washington Twp., Warren Co., NJ census lists John Everett as a 76 year-old widower. Living with him were John Everett, Jr., a 30 year-old widower, and 5 year-old daughter Lizzie Everett.

The death certificate for John Everitt identifies his parents as Jesse and Catharine Everitt, and states John died a widower on 6 Apr 1889 at age 84y2m in Bethlehem Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. (1888-89.55.E53)

Notes for Elizabeth Cowell:

Death certificate 1878-79.95.E11

John Everitt and Elizabeth Cowell had the following children:

i. WHITFIELD HOLLOWAY<sup>3</sup> EVERITT was born on 01 Oct 1833. He died on 01 Sep 1856.

Notes for Whitfield Holloway Everitt:

Whitfield Everitt's birth date has been calculated from his tombstone inscription which states he died 1 Sep 1856 at age 22y11m.

ii. Jesse Everitt was born on 11 Feb 1836. He died on 13 Feb 1838.

Notes for Jesse Everitt:

Jesse Everitt's birth date has been calculated from his tombstone inscription which states he died 13 Feb 1838 at age 2y2d.

- iii. LYDIA ANN EVERITT was born about 1839.
- iv. JOHN EVERITT was born in 1850. He died on 21 Nov 1905 in Washington Twp., Warren Co., NJ (Washington Cemetery, Warren Co., NJ). He married Rebecca Jane Moore, daughter of John Moore and Lena Bissler, on 13 Jan 1881 in Asbury, Warren Co., NJ (Rev. Geo. W. Fourson [?]). She was born on 05 Sep 1858. She died on 20 Jun 1920 in Washington, Warren Co., NJ (Washington Cemetery, Warren Co., NJ).

Notes for John Everitt:

The certificate for the 13 Jan 1881 Asbury, Warren Co., NJ marriage of 30 year-old John Everitt of Washington, Warren Co., NJ and 22 year-old Rebekah Moore of Asbury, Warren Co., NJ identifies John's parents as John Everitt and Eliz. Cowell, and Rebekah's parents as John Moore and Laurie [?] Fusler. The certificate states this was John Everitt's second marriage. Rev. Geo. W. Fourson [?] officiated.

John and Rebecca Everitt appear on the 1900 Washington, Warren Co., NJ census, which states they had been married 18 years, and that Rebecca had had one child who was no longer alive. (A Willie A. Everitt, who died 11 Feb 1884 at age 1m, is buried in the same section of Washington Cemetery as John's parents.

# Generation 2 (con't)

It is not certain he was John and Rebecca's son.)

The death certificate for John Everitt identifies his parents as John and Elizabeth Everitt, and states John was a butcher who resided in Washington, Warren Co., NJ, where he died, married, on 21 Nov 1905. Burial was in Washington Cemetery.

Notes for Rebecca Jane Moore:

Rebecca Everitt is listed as a widow on the 1910 and 1920 Washington, Warren Co., NJ censuses. Living with her was her sister, Margaret Moore.

The death certificate for Rebecca Jane Everitt identifies her parents as John Moore and Lena Bissler, and states Rebecca died, the widow of John Everitt, on 20 Jun 1920 at age 61y9m15d at her residence in Washington, Warren Co., NJ. The informant for the certificate was Miss Margaret Moore of the same residence.

(John and Rebecca's marriage certificate gives the maiden name of Rebecca's mother as Fusler.)

3. RACHEL<sup>2</sup> EVERITT (Jesse<sup>1</sup>) was born on 07 Jun 1809 in Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 05 Mar 1895 in Marksboro, Warren Co., NJ (Marksboro Presbyterian Churchyard, Warren Co., NJ). She married Alexander H. Thomson, son of Robert C. Thomson and Maria Woodruff, on 19 Aug 1830. He was born on 09 Nov 1805 in Marksboro, Frelinghuysen Twp., Warren Co., NJ. He died on 10 Sep 1840 in Warren Co., NJ (Marksboro Presbyterian Churchyard, Warren Co., NJ).

Notes for Rachel Everitt:

The 1850 to 1880 Frelinghuysen Twp., Warren Co., NJ censuses list Rachel Thomson / Thompson and her brother Matthias Everitt. Living with them in 1850 were Rachel's daughters Susan D., Mary, and Jane W., as well as Rachel's mother, 62 year-old Catharine Everitt. In 1880, grandchildren Kate Van Warcom (4y) and Clarence Tuthill (13y) are listed.

The death certificate for Rachel Thompson states she was born in Hunterdon Co., NJ, the daughter of Jesse Everett and Catharine Cramer, and resided in Marksboro, Warren Co., NJ, where she died, the widow of Alexander H., on 5 Mar 1895 at age 85y8m28d. Burial was in Marksboro Cemetery. (1894-95.95.T127)

Notes for Alexander H. Thomson:

Posted on the Findagrave site for Dr. Alexander Hamilton Thomson is the following article from Francis Bazley Lee's "Genealogical and Memorial History of the State of New Jersey":

(III) Alexander Hamilton, son of Robert C. and Maria (Woodruff) Thomson, was born in the old homestead at Marksboro, which is still standing. He graduated from Princeton College in 1824 and then took his degree from the Medical School of the University of Pennsylvania. He then began the practice of his profession at Marksboro, where he lived for the greater part of his life, combining with his medical services the management of a farm and milling business. He married August 19 1830 Rachel Everitt, born June 7 1809. Children 1. Susan Dowers 2. Elizabeth Catharine 3. Mary (referred to below) 4. Jane Woodruff. (IV) Mary, daughter of Dr Alexander Hamilton and Rachel (Everitt) Thomson, of Marksboro, Warren County, New Jersey, married August 17 1871, Lewis, son of William and Catharine A (Sutton) Van Blarcom.

She married (1) LEWIS VAN BLARCOM, son of William Van Blarcom and Catherine Sutton, on 17 Aug 1871. He was born on 19 Jul 1835. He died on 20 Feb 1904. She married (2) JAMES W. CUMMINS. He was born in 1836. He died on 27 Oct 1863 (Marksboro Presbyterian Churchyard, Warren Co., NJ).

4. MARY³ THOMSON (Rachel² Everitt, Jesse¹ Everitt) was born on 05 Jun 1837 in Marksboro, Frelinghuysen Twp., Warren Co., NJ. She died on 05 Oct 1916 (Newton Cemetery, Sussex Co., NJ). She married (1) Lewis Van Blarcom, son of William Van Blarcom and Catherine Sutton, on 17 Aug 1871. He was born on 19 Jul 1835. He died on 20 Feb 1904. She married (2) James W. Cummins. He was born in 1836. He died on 27 Oct 1863 (Marksboro Presbyterian Churchyard, Warren Co., NJ).

Notes for Lewis Van Blarcom:

The following appears on the Findagrave site for Lewis Van Blarcom: "Civil War Union Army Officer. Captain of Company C, 15th New Jersey Volunteer Infantry. On Aug. 25, 1862, Mr. Van Blarcom enlisted as first lieutenant, Company D, Fifteenth Regiment New Jersey Volunteers, and for meritorious service he was promoted in June, 1863, to captain of Company C. This regiment was a part of the First New Jersey Brigade, which formed a part of the Army of the Potomac, First Division, Sixth Army Corps. Capt. Van Blarcom was in the following engagements: Fredericksburg, December, 1862; second Fredericksburg, at Salem Heights, May, 1863; Gettysburg, July, 1863; Rappahannock Station, November, 1863; Spottsylvania, May 8, 1864. In this last engagement he was wounded and captured by the rebels, and had his leg amputated by them. After remaining in the hospital for ten days, he was carried to Richmond and placed in Libby Prison, where he remained until Sept. 12, 1864, when he was exchanged and placed in the hospital at Annapolis. He received his discharge from service on Dec. 19, 1864, and returned home. After his return to Newton he resumed the study of the law, which he completed, and was admitted to the bar as an attorney at Trenton, at the June term in 1865, and as counselor at the June term in 1868. After his admission as an attorney he began the practice of law in Newton, where he has successfully practiced his profession since.... He was appointed prosecutor of pleas by Governor Randolph, March 25, 1869, and discharged the duties of that office with acknowledged ability and justice for a term of five years. Capt. Van Blarcom is, politically, a Republican, and leading and influential in his party in Sussex County. . . . He married, Aug. 17, 1871, Mary, daughter of Dr. Alexander H. Thompson, of Marksborough, Warren Co., N.J. His children are Kate and Andrew."

- 5. ii. Andrew Van Blarcom was born on 12 Nov 1880. He died on 25 Jan 1944 (Newton Cemetery, Sussex Co., NJ). He married Sara S. Riker. She was born on 06 Feb 1882. She died on 28 Nov 1962 (Newton Cemetery, Sussex Co., NJ).
