

Descendants of John Everitt

Generation 1

1. **JOHN¹ EVERITT** was born in 1788 in Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on 07 Sep 1867 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. He married **MARY ANN APGAR**. She was born on 28 Jul 1789 in Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 10 Apr 1877 in Hunterdon Co., NJ.

Notes for John Everitt:

Census records cited in this family history sometimes reflect the changing boundaries of Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co. In 1861, part of Readington Twp. was transferred to Tewksbury Twp., and in 1871 and 1891, parts of Tewksbury Twp. became part of Clinton Twp. (See John F. Snyder's "The Story of New Jersey's Civil Boundaries: 1606 - 1968.")

Some of the birth and marriage dates cited here come from records of the Zion Lutheran Church, Oldwick, NJ. The sources for other specific dates are cited in the notes.

John and Mary Everet appear on the 1850 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census with daughter Amanda. The 1860 Tewksbury census lists them as John and Mary Everett, and a 6 year-old Mary F. is listed with them. (It is doubtful Mary was a daughter.) By 1860, daughter Amanda had married Jackson Potter, and lived next to John and Mary Everett.

John Everitt died intestate and administration of his estate was granted to David L. Everitt and Peter A. Everitt on 26 Sep 1867. The Orphans' Court approved the sale of John's property to pay his debts. Nine acres of Tewksbury Twp. land, including John's house and barn, were sold to William Eick. The property was adjacent to lands of William Eick and Peter P. Alpaugh. A wood lot was adjacent to W. Apgar and Peter Melick.

In its listing of Lebanon Reformed Cemetery burials, the "Genealogical Magazine of New Jersey" gives John Everett's date of death as 7 Sep 1868 (Vol.31, p.36).

NOTE: John and Mary Everitt may also have had a son, Nathan Lake Everitt, who was born 8 Nov 1823 and died in Pensacola, Escambia Co., FL on 13 Sep 1895. Nathan, his wife and son appear on the 1850 Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co. census living next to David and Ellen Everitt. Nathan and David were both blacksmiths. Hunterdon Co. marriage records document the 28 Oct 1848 marriage of Nathan L. Everitt to Anna Deats. Nathan Everitt has not been located on the 1860 census, but appears in Pensacola in 1870. The 1870 census indicates Nathan resided in Virginia by 1854, for two children are listed, ages 12 and 14, as having been born in VA. The next child, Walter, was born in Louisiana. The death certificate of Walter Everitt states he was born 27 Oct 1868 in New Orleans. Anna (Deats) Everitt apparently died in the 1860s, for the same certificate identifies Walter's parents as Nathan Lake Everitt, born in NJ, and Mary Ann Tate, born in AL. Nathan is tentatively entered here as a son of John and Mary Everitt.

Notes for Mary Ann Apgar:

The 1870 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists 75 year-old Mary Everett with her son-in-law and daughter, Andrew J. and Amanda Jackson.

Mary Everitt's death record states she died a widow in High Bridge on 10 Apr 1877 of consumption at age 88y. Her parents are identified as Peter and Mary Ann Apgar.

Mary Ann Apgar's birth date has been calculated from her tombstone inscription, which indicates she died at age 87y8m21d.

Mary Ann Apgar's sister, Sarah Apgar, married William Beavers. Their son, Peter A. Beavers, married Rachel Fritts on 3 May 1838, and among their children was William C. Beavers, who married Mary Jane Everitt, the daughter of David L. and Ellen Louise (Apgar) Everitt. David L. Everitt was Mary Ann (Apgar) Everitt's son.

She died on 04 May 1858. He married (2) REBECCA HOFFMAN POST, daughter of William Hoffman and Ellen, on 01 Nov 1860 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. R. Van Horn). She was born on 25 Mar 1822 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 09 Oct 1896 in High Bridge, Hunterdon Co., NJ.

She married Asa Tiger, son of John Tiger and Sarah Everitt, on 14 Mar 1829 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Pohlman). He was born about 1808 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died in 1890 in Hunterdon Co., NJ.

Notes for Mary A. Everitt:

Asa and Mary A. Tiger appear on Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ censuses from 1850 to 1870. The 1880 Tewksbury census shows Asa Tiger, a 74 year-old widower, and his 27 year-old son, William.

Notes for Peter Apgar Everitt:

An obituary for Peter Everett appeared in the 6 Aug 1900 "Easton Express" and states Peter died 4 Aug 1900 in Potterstown at the age of 86y. Peter was survived by his wife and the following children: John and Frank, both of Potterstown; Mrs. Samuel Beers and Mrs. Jacob Gorgas, both of Phillipsburg; Mrs. Charles Hay, of Easton; and Mrs. William Weyler, of Port Morris, NJ. (Peter Everett's tombstone gives 5 Aug 1900 as his date of death.)

Notes for Amanda Everitt:

Amanda Everitt's birth date has been calculated from her tombstone inscription, which indicates she died at age 5y4m13d.

14. v. MARY HANNAH EVERITT was born on 03 Oct 1848 in NJ. She died on 12 Apr 1918 in Phillipsburg, Warren Co., NJ. She married Jacob Gorgas, son of Charles Gorgas and Elizabeth Skinner, on 24 Sep 1868 in Warren Co., NJ. He was born on 11 Jul 1846 in Greenwich Twp., Warren Co., NJ. He died on 27 Jun 1900 in Phillipsburg, Warren Co., NJ.
 15. vi. ALTHA EVERITT was born in Jun 1850 in NJ. She died after 1930. She married Charles H. Hay about 1870. He was born in Aug 1848 in PA. He died between 1920-1930.
 16. vii. FRANK ELWOOD EVERITT was born in Jul 1858 in NJ. He died after 1930. He married MARION E. KENT. She was born in Sep 1861 in PA. She died after 1930.
4. **DAVID L.² EVERITT** (John¹) was born on 05 Jul 1816 in Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. He died on 08 Sep 1902. He married (1) **ELLEN LOUISA APGAR**, daughter of Herbert Apgar and Mary Crammer, on 04 Nov 1843 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Van Amburgh). She was born on 11 May 1824 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 04 May 1858. He married (2) **REBECCA HOFFMAN POST**, daughter of William Hoffman and Ellen, on 01 Nov 1860 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. R. Van Horn). She was born on 25 Mar 1822 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died on 09 Oct 1896 in High Bridge, Hunterdon Co., NJ.

Notes for David L. Everitt:

The Lebanon Dutch Reformed Church records indicate David L. Everitt was born 5 Jul 1816 and baptised 31 Aug 1816. David's tombstone, however, states he was born 23 Jan 1816.

The 1850 to 1870 Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ censuses list David L. Everitt. In 1850 David appears with his wife, Ellen L. and children Caroline, Mary J., and James. The 1860 census shows the widowed David with children Caroline, Jane, James B., Anna H., and Frances. Living with David in 1870 were Lina D. Conover (5), Garret M. Conover (3), and Mary S. Conover (2). David's second wife, Rebecca, and two of his children, Anna and Francis, appear on the 1870 Clinton Twp. census living with Nicholas and Mary Tiger. David L. and Rebecca Everitt appear on the High Bridge Twp., Hunterdon Co. censuses of 1880 and 1895. In 1880, David lived next to his son, James B., and his family. David L. Everitt's last census appearance is on the 1900 High Bridge census, where he is listed as an 84 year-old widower.

Generation 2 (con't)

The Conover children living with David L. Everitt in 1870 appear on the 1880 High Bridge census as children of T. Y. and Sarah C. Conover. The 27 Oct 1858 "Hunterdon County Democrat" announced the 19 Oct 1858 marriage, by Rev. R. Van Amburg, of Theodore Y. Conover to Sarah A. Sharp, of Clinton. It is not known why the Conover children were living with David Everitt. Theodore and Sarah A. Conover were living in Clinton Twp. in 1870, appearing with a son, Elmer E. (Appearing on the same census page were Rebecca Everitt and two of David L. Everitt's children living with the Tiger family.)

20. v. RUTH ANN EVERITT was born on 10 Oct 1853 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She married Theodore Fowler on 03 May 1871 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Van Amburgh). He was born in Jul 1850 in NJ.
- vi. FANNY LOUISA EVERITT was born in 1858 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She died after 1910. She married Conover L. Van Syckle, son of Andrew Van Syckle and Lydia S. Conover, on 30 Dec 1875 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Dean). He was born on 01 Feb 1846 in NJ. He died in May 1906 in Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ.

Notes for Fanny Louisa Everitt:

The 1880 Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists Garret C. and Fanny Vansickle. The couple appears as Conover and Fannie L. Van Sickle on the 1900 Clinton Twp. census, and the census-taker states Conover and Fannie had been married 26 years and that Fannie had had two children, neither of whom was alive. (The census-taker also states Fannie was born Oct 1859. However, Fannie's mother died 4 May 1858, and Fanny [Francis] was 2 years-old on the 1860 census.) Conover died before the 1910 census, for Fanny L. Vansyckle appears on the Clinton Twp. census that year as a 50 year-old widow.

Notes for Conover L. Van Syckle:

John W. Van Sickle's 1880 "A History of the Van Sickle Family in the United States of America" includes a detailed genealogy of Van Sickles in Hunterdon Co., NJ.

The Last Will and Testament of Conover Van Sickle, written 3 Jan 1906 and proved 28 May 1906, places him in Clinton Twp. and identifies his wife as Fannie L. Van Sickle. Witnesses were Enoch Blackwell and Jeanette Fowler (Bk.22, p.248).

- vii. SUSAN C. EVERITT.

Notes for Susan C. Everitt:

Susan C. Everitt is buried near her parents, David L. and Ellen Everitt, but her tombstone is apparently unreadable, as published transcriptions only indicate she was 9 months old and died 18__6. There is no record of her birth in church records.

Notes for Rebecca Hoffman Post:

Generation 2 (con't)

Rebecca Post Everitt's Last Will and Testament, written 21 Jul 1890 and proved 22 Oct 1896, names James B. Everitt and Octavius P. Chamberlin as executors, and identifies her husband as David L. Everitt, to whom she left her estate. Rebecca's will also names "the children and heirs at law of my said husband" as: Caroline Hixson, wife of John Hixson; Jane Beavers, wife of William C. Beavers; Anna Fowler, wife of Theodore Fowler; Fanny Louisa Van Syckle, wife of Conover Van Syckle; and, James B. Everitt.

The death certificate of Rebecca Everitt identifies her parents as William and Ellen Hoffman, and states she died in High Bridge, NJ on 9 Oct 1896 at age 74y6m14d. (Rebecca's birth date has been calculated from the death certificate information.)

Rebecca Post Everett is buried in the Readington Reformed Church Cemetery next to her first husband, Peter Q. Post, who died 16 Sep 1854. Peter's death was noted in the 20 Sep 1854 "Hunterdon County Democrat": "At Readington, on Saturday the 16th inst., of Typhoid Fever, Mr. Peter Q. Post, aged 30 years." Peter Q. Post had married Rebecca Hoffman on 15 Feb 1844. The 1850 Readington Twp. census lists 25 year-old Peter Q. Post with 28 year-old Rebecca and 5 year-old William.

The 7 Nov 1860 "Hunterdon County Democrat" announced the marriage of David L. Everitt and Rebecca Post: "Nov. 1 by Rev. R. Van Horn, David L. Everitt, esq., of Clinton, to Mrs. Rebecca Post of Tewksbury." Not until 1880 does Rebecca appear with David L. Everitt. In 1870, Rebecca Everitt, 18 year-old Anna Everitt, and 12 year-old Francis Everitt are listed on the Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co. census living with the family of Nicholas and Mary Tiger.

5. **NATHAN LAKE² EVERITT** (John¹) was born on 08 Nov 1823 in NJ. He died on 13 Sep 1895 in Pensacola, Escambia Co., FL (Saint John's Cemetery, Pensacola, Escambia Co., FL (Section 12)). He married (1) **ANNA DEATS** on 28 Oct 1848 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Collier). She was born about 1826 in NJ. She died between 1858-1868. He married (2) **MARY SCOTT**.

Nathan Lake Everitt and Anna Deats had the following children:

6. **RACHEL² EVERITT** (John¹) was born on 01 Feb 1827 in Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. She married Phillip E. Apgar, son of Peter B. Apgar and Ellen, on 19 Dec 1846 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Van Amburgh). He was born on 24 Oct 1824 in NJ. He died on 15 Jan 1890.

Notes for Rachel Everitt:

Hunterdon Co., NJ censuses from 1850 to 1870 list Philip and Rachel Apgar. In 1850, the

family appear in Readington Twp., and in 1860 are listed on the Tewksbury Twp. census with three children: Alford B., Mary E., and Enoch. In 1860 Philip and Rachel lived next to Philip's parents, Peter B. and Ellen Apgar. The 1870 census lists 20 year-old Mary E. Johnson and 1 year-old Allace J. Johnson with the Apgars. By 1880 Philip and Rachel appear on the Readington Twp. with 11 year-old Allis J. Johnson, identified as Alfred's granddaughter. (On the same 1880 census page John C. and Fanny Everitt are listed, with children Katie and Peter E.)

Notes for Phillip E. Apgar:

Phillip E. Apgar's sister, Mary Ann, married Samuel Everitt, son of Joseph and Elizabeth (Lance) Everitt.

Phillip E. Apgar and Rachel Everitt had the following children:

Harvey E. Hay appears with his parents, Charles H. and Altha Hay, at 223 Church St. on Easton, Northampton Co., PA censuses from 1900 to 1920. Each census states Harvey was a silk weaver.

40. iii. **HERBERT CHARLES HAY** was born on 19 Nov 1878 in Easton, Northampton Co., PA. He married Mary A about 1908. She was born about 1882 in NJ.

Alpaugh with a 3 year-old daughter, Emma E. Death records show that Emma E. Alpaugh died 24 Jan 1885 at age 8y1m in Bedminster (1884-85.86.A1), and Asa W. Alpaugh died 28 Jan 1885 at age 4y5m (1884-85.86.A2). The 10 Feb 1885 "Hunterdon County Democrat" reported: "There were three deaths from diphtheria in Pluckamin week before last. Mr. James Alpaugh lost both of his children, a girl and boy, aged 8 and 5, within four or five days of each other; and Mr. S. K. Hoffman his only child, a girl, aged 7."

James S. Alpaugh died 27 Apr 1885 at age 28y1m (1884-85.55.A13). Three years later, Mary (Lake) Alpaugh married Samuel J. Hoffman. The marriage was noted in the 13 Nov 1888 "Hunterdon County Democrat": "Nov. 3, 1888, at Glen Gardner, by the Rev. J. W. Lake, Samuel J. Hoffman, of Peapack, and Mrs. Mary L. Alpaugh, of Cokesburg." Samuel J. Hoffman may be the S. K. Hoffman of the above newspaper report. Samuel J. Hoffman first married Sophia D. Tiger in 1873 (Bk.BM, p.529). "Early Germans of New Jersey" states that Sophia D. Philhower, daughter of John and Barbara (Apgar) Philhower of Peapack, Somerset Co., first married Jacob Tiger and then married Joseph Hoffman (p.461). The 1880 Chester Twp., Morris Co., NJ lists 32 year-old Samuel J. and 45 year-old Sophia D. Hoffman.

Samuel J. and Mary L. Hoffman appear on Chester Twp., Morris Co., NJ censuses with two sons, Samuel J. and John J. Living with the Hoffmans in 1900 was 20 year-old Frank B. Alpaugh, surely the son of Jacob R. and Catharine (Lake) Alpaugh. The 1910 census-taker indicates Samuel and Mary had been married 21 years and that Mary had had six children, two of whom were still alive. The same census also states both Samuel and Mary had been previously married. Samuel Hoffman apparently died before 1920, for Mary L. Hoffman lived with her son, Samuel Jr., in 1920, and is listed as a widow in 1930.

Peter Everitt's obituary appeared in the 7 Sep 1944 issue of the "Hunterdon County Democrat." The obituary also indicates Peter was 79 yrs. old and was born in Potterstown, the son of John C. and Fannie (Bush) Everitt.
