2. JESSE<sup>2</sup> EVERITT (*JOSEPH<sup>1</sup>*) was born 1808, and died 09 Jun 1887. He married MARIA GULICK 15 May 1834 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Schultz), daughter of JOHN GULICK and BARBARA APGAR. She was born 21 May 1817, and died 28 Jun 1897.

Notes for JESSE EVERITT:

The 1840 Lebanon Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists 30-40 year-old Jesse Everitt, whose household included a male 15-20, two females 0-5, one female 10-15, and one female 20-30. The oldest female would be Jesse's wife, Maria, who was born about 1816. And the youngest females are surely Jesse and Maria's daughters, Mary and Sarah. The identity of the other male and female is unknown. Jesse and Maria Evert next appear on the 1850 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co. census with children Mary E., Sarah A., Margaretta, David A., Cornelia, and Ann H. The family, listed as Everett, also appears in Tewksbury Twp. on the 1860 census, by which time three more children appear: Ellen, Martha, and Laura. By 1870, Jesse and Maria had moved to Readington Twp., Hunterdon Co. They are listed there as Evert and appear with three daughters, Ellen B., Martha J., and Laura A. The 1880 Readington Twp. census lists Jesse and Mariah Everitt with daughter Laura.

3. SAMUEL C.<sup>2</sup> EVERITT (*JOSEPH<sup>1</sup>*) was born 27 May 1817 in Hunterdon Co., NJ, and died Bet. 1870 - 1880. He married MARY ANN APGAR 26 Nov 1845, daughter of PETER APGAR and ELLEN LEWIS. She was born Abt. 1824 in Hunterdon Co., NJ, and died Bet. 1910 - 1920.

Notes for SAMUEL C. EVERITT:

Samuel and Mary Ann Everitt appear on the 1850 and 1860 censuses for Bridgewater, Somerset Co., NJ. Three children are listed in 1850: Peter, Jacob, and Sarah Ellen. The 1860 census lists four more children: John, Samuel, Emily, and Alfred. By 1870, Samuel and Mary moved to Piscataway Twp., Middlesex Co., NJ, and had

10 children, 9 appearing with them on the census; the three additional children were Anna, Mary, and William. (The oldest, Peter, was absent.)

The 1880 North Plainfield, Somerset Co. census lists 58 year-old Mary Everitt, by then a widow, with five of her children: Sarah E., Samuel C., Emley E., Alfred, and Mary E. Still in North Plainfield in 1900, 77 year-old Mary A. Everitt appears with: daughter Sarah E. Kline, a widow; daughter Mary E. Bosterlie, a widow; niece Jennie M. Everitt; and, son Alfred J. Everitt. Boarding with the family was 63 year-old Fred Smith.

Notes for MARY ANN APGAR:

Mary Ann Apgar's brother, Phillip E., married Rachel Everitt, daughter of John and Mary Ann (Apgar) Everitt.

Notes for SARAH ELLEN EVERITT:

Sarah E. Everitt appears as the 50 year-old widow, Sarah E. Kline, on the 1900 North Plainfield, Somerset Co., NJ census. She was living with Mary A. Everitt and is identified as Mary's daughter. The 1910 North Plainfield census lists 59 year-old widow, Sarah Coddington, living with her sister, widow Mary E. Bosterle, and mother, 87 year-old Mary E. Bosterle [actually Everitt]. The 1920 and 1930 North Plainfield census shows Sarah Coddington living with her brother, Samuel Everett, at 78 Fairview Ave. The informant for Samuel C. Everitt's 1937 death certificate was Sarah Ellen Coddington of 78 Fairview Ave.

Notes for SAMUEL CLARENCE EVERITT:

Samuel Everitt's death certificate gives his full name and states he was born 26 Jul 1854, the son of Samuel C. Everitt and Mary Ann Apgar, and that Samuel died single on 15 Oct 1937 at 78 Fairview Ave., North Plainfield, Somerset Co., NJ at age 83y2m20d. The informant for the certificate was Sarah Ellen Coddington. The 1930 North Plainfield, Somerset Co., NJ census lists Samuel Everett and Sarah Coddington at 78 Fairview Ave. The census-taker identifies Sarah Coddington as Samuel's sister.

Notes for ALFRED J. EVERITT:

Alfred J. Everitt's death certificate states he was born 3 Jun 1859, the son of Samuel Everitt and Mary A. Apgar, and that Alfred died single on 3 Oct 1913 in the Muhlenberg Hospital, Plainfield, NJ, at age 54y4m0d. The informant for the certificate was Samuel C. Everitt.

4. CHARITY ANN<sup>2</sup> EVERITT (*JOSEPH*<sup>1</sup>) was born 05 Dec 1821 in Hunterdon Co., NJ, and died 1894 in Hunterdon Co., NJ. She married CALVIN COLUMBUS LANDON 23 Mar 1839 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Van Cleve), son of DAVID LANDON and POLLY CROOKS. He was born 1797 in Brandon, Rutland Co., VT, and died 1872 in Hunterdon Co., NJ.

Notes for CHARITY ANN EVERITT:

Circumstantial evidence suggests that it was Joseph and Elizabeth Everitt's daughter, Charity, who married Calvin Landon on 23 Mar 1839. Hunterdon Co. marriage records give her name as Charity Everitt, and the 1870 census lists her as Charity A. Landing. (As the marriage record and censuses show, the spelling of Calvin's surname varies on documents. It is, however, as Landon that the surname appears most frequently.) Calvin and Charity appear from 1850 to 1870 on Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ censuses. The 1850 census lists them with five children: James, Steven, Harmon, John, and Peter D. By 1860, Calvin and Charity had two more sons, Fletcher L. and Abraham. According to researcher Carole Halfpop of the "Porter Research Site Database," Calvin and Charity also had a son, George, who died an infant in 1852.

Charity A. Landon's tombstone states she was born 1819 and died 1894.

Notes for CALVIN COLUMBUS LANDON:

According to researcher Carole Halfpop of the "Porter Research Site Database," Calvin Columbus Landon, Sr. was born 1797 in Brandon, VT, the son of David Landon and Polly Crooks, and died 1872 in Lebanon, NJ. Calvin was first married to Nabby Smith on 22 Dec 1820, and their children were John William Landon, Calvin Columbus, Jr. Landon, Mary Eliza Landon, and Eleanor S. Landon. Calvin's second wife was Mary E. Marsh, and their children were Susan A. Landon and Sarah A. Landon. Then, on 23 Mar 1839, Calvin married Charity Everitt in High Bridge, Hunterdon Co., NJ. Halfpop states Calvin and Charity's children were James Landon, (Henry) Steven Landon, Harmon Landon, John Landon, Peter D. Landon, George A. Landon, Fletcher Loomis Landon, and Abraham Landon.

The 1850 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists 10 year-old James Landon with his parents, Calvin and Charity Landon, and his siblings. A 20 year-old James Landon, a farm laborer, is found on the 1860 Clinton Twp., Hunterdon Co. census living with John M. and Hannah Apgar and their children.

She married AARON P. SUTTON 11 Sep 1858 in Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ S.134, son of PETER SUTTON and SARAH PICKLE. He was born 30 Aug 1836 in NJ, and died 16 Jul 1896 in Plainfield, Union Co., NJ.

Notes for SARAH ANN EVERITT:

Aaron P. and Sarah Sutton appear on the 1860 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census with 1 year-old daughter Emaline. By 1870, Aaron remarried Rebecca Voorhees and lived in Westfield, Union Co., NJ. Aaron and Rebecca are seen with three children: 10 year-old Emaline, 9 year-old Wesley, and 1 year-old Stephen. The family lived next to David and Rachel Everitt, and their son Edward. (David Everitt was Sarah's brother, and thus Aaron's brother-in-law.) Aaron and Rebecca would have four children: Stephen, Willard, Frederick, and Lillie.

Notes for WESLEY B. SUTTON:

Wesley Sutton appears on the 1870 Westfield, Union Co., NJ census with his father, Aaron Sutton, and step-mother, Rebecca, and with his sister, Emaline. An 18 year-old Wesley B. Sutton, who was born in NJ, as were his parents, is listed at the Jefferson Barracks on the 1880 Carondelet, St. Louis Co., MO census. Wesley was a soldier and trumpeter.

The 29 Apr 1884 "Hunterdon County Democrat" noted the following death: "At Dunellen, April 24, 1884, Wesley B. Sutton, aged 22 years and 6 months."

Notes for MARGARET EVERITT:

The 1870 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists James and Margaret Barker with five children: George M., William J., Theodore L., Sarah A., and Lilly M. The family lived near Henry and Mary Pickel and their children. Mary Pickel was Mary Everitt, Margaret's sister. Interestingly, in 1860 Henry and Mary Pickle lived in Washington Twp., Morris Co., NJ next to Adam R. Peer, who would become Margaret's second husband. The 11 Jan 1876 "Hunterdon County Democrat" noted the following marriage: "By Rev. J. A. Davis, Dec. 22, A. R. Peer, to Margareta Backer, all of Pottersville."

The 58 year-old Adam R. and 39 year-old Margaret Peer appear on the 1880 Tewksbury Twp. census. Living with them were 4 year-old daughter Laura Peer, as well as 11 year-old Lillie B. Barker and 8 year-old James Barker, identified as Adam Peer's step-children. By 1895, the family moved to Bedminster Twp., Somerset Co., NJ. R\_?\_ and Margaret Peer are listed with James Barker, Charles and Laura Wilson, and Franklin Wilson. The 1900 Bedminster Twp. census reveals that Charles and Laura Wilson were Margaret Peer's son-in-law and daughter. Margaret lived with the Wilsons in 1900 and was then a widow.

Notes for ADAM R. PEER:

Adam R. Peer married Julia A. Sutton, a widow, on 30 Nov 1850. The 1850 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census shows Adam R. Peer with three children -- Gilbert, Sarah, and George -- and a 30 year-old Julia A. Sutton. The impression is that Adam had an even earlier wife. The 1860 Washington Twp., Morris Co., NJ census lists Adam R. and Julia A. Peer, who appear with seven children, including Gilbert and Sarah. An 80 year-

old Mary Sutton lived with the family. In 1860, Adam Peer lived near Henry and Mary Pickle. Jesse and Maria Everitt's daughter, Mary, married Henry Pickle in 1856.

9. CORNELIA FISHER<sup>3</sup> EVERITT (*JESSE*<sup>2</sup>, *JOSEPH*<sup>1</sup>) was born 14 Nov 1846 in Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ, and died 02 Jun 1912 in Westfield, Union Co., NJ. She married JOHN VAN CLEIF PICKELL 04 May 1867 in Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Heward) BG.421, son of MINARD PICKELL and MARGARET LANCE. He was born 27 Apr 1847 in NJ, and died 13 Nov 1916 in Westfield, Union Co., NJ.

Notes for CORNELIA FISHER EVERITT:

D'Autrechy summarizes a Hunterdon Co. record (Recog. 393) that indicates Cornelia Everett, a single woman of Tewksbury Twp., gave birth to a son on 14 Nov 1864, whose father is identified as Martin B. Hyler (Vol.II, p.90). Cornelia married John Pickle 4 May 1867, and the 1870 Readington Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists John V. and Cornelia Pickle with two children: 5 year-old Martin H. and 2 year-old Emma Jane.

John V. and Cornelia Pickell also appear on the 1880 Readington Twp. census, this time with 15 year-old Martin and 7 year-old Robert. By 1900, John and Cornelia moved to Westfield, Union Co., NJ, appearing on the census with an adopted daughter, Wilmina Gulick, who was born Jun 1881. John and Cornelia's last census appearance is in 1910 in Westfield. With them were grandchildren William H. Pickell and Walter Pickell. (The 1900 census-taker states Cornelia had had three children, two of whom were still alive, while the 1910 census indicates she had had two children, both of whom were alive.)

Notes for ROBERT L. PICKELL:

Robert L. and Alice B. Pickell are listed on the 1895 Westfield, Union Co., NJ census. They have not been found on the 1900 census, but reappear on the 1910 Brooklyn, Kings Co., NY census. Living with them in 1910 were Helen R. Melvin and Agnes D. Melvin, identified as Robert's sisters-in-law. The census-taker records that Robert and Alice had been married 15 years. (The 1880 Brooklyn census shows Helen, Alice, and Agnes with their parents, Wm. and Charlotte A. Melvin, and with their other siblings.) By 1920, Robert and Alice returned to Westville and were living on Lambert Mill Road, where they also lived in 1930. With them in 1930 was 44 year-old and single William Pickell, identified as Robert's nephew. Robert and William were carpenters.

Notes for JACOB E. EVERITT:

Jacob Everitt married Josephine Shepherd by 1880, and appears with her, and their son, Charles S., on the 1880 Orange, Essex Co., NJ census. The family lived next to Jacob's brother, John, and his wife, Abbie, and their two children. By 1900, Josephine had died, and Jacob and his brother, Samuel, boarded with the Calfax family in Orange. The 1900 census-taker indicates Jacob was a widower and Samuel was single, and that both worked as hatters. The death certificate for Jacob E. Everitt states he was born 8 Oct 1848, the son of Samuel Everitt and Mary A. Apgar, and that Jacob died a widower on 27 Apr 1931 in Tewksbury, Hunterdon Co., NJ at age 82y8m20d. The informant for the certificate was Nancy Apgar of Lebanon, NJ.

On the 1850 census, Calvin Landon is recorded as born in VT. The 1930 Willow Glen, Santa Clara Co. census lists Sarah C. Landon, an 81 year-old widow, and her son and daughter-in-law, Raymond E. and Ruth Landon.

Raymond E. Landon appears with his parents, Peter D. and Sarah C. Landon, on the 1900 and 1910 San Jose Twp., Santa Clara Co., CA censuses. By 1920, Raymond had moved to Davenport, Scott Co., IA. Raymond is listed as 24 years old and single. (It is not known what happened to the wife and child mentioned on the draft registration card.) The 1930 CA census shows him back in Santa Clara, where he and his wife, Ruth, lived in Willow Glen with Raymond's mother, Sarah C. Landon, then an 81 year-old widow. Barker who was born in NJ, as were his parents, living as a farm laborer with the family of 37 year-old Jacob A. Melick, who also was born in NJ. The 1850 Tewksbury Twp. census lists 8 year-old Jacob A. Melick with his parents, John W. and Elizabeth A. Melick. Jacob was in IL by 1870.

George Barker appears as George M. Barker on the 1900 Wheatland Twp., Bureau Co., IL census. He was married to Olive and had four children. The census-taker states George and Olive had been married 14 years. The 1910 and 1920 Milo Twp. censuses show George and Oliva Barker. The earlier census lists three children: Burton, Alba, and Beulah. The later census also lists Alba and Beulah, but also appearing with the family was George's daughter-in-law, Gertrude Barker, and 8 month-old grandson, Byron E. Barker. George Barker's wife died before 1930, for the Milo Twp. census that year lists George Barker as a 72 year-old widower living next to his son, Carl Barker, and his family.

He married ISADORE SHURTS Abt. 1891 in IL, daughter of DAVID SHURTS and ADALINE. She was born Mar 1867 in IL, and died Aft. 1930.

Notes for WILLIAM JESSE BARKER:

Evidence suggests that after the death of James Barker, sons William Jesse Barker and Theodore Barker moved to Saratoga Twp., Marshall Co., IL. The 1880 Saratoga Twp. census lists a 22 year-old Jessey Barker who was born in NJ, as were his parents, residing as a farm laborer with William and Eliza Schirtz, who also were born in NJ. Two pages earlier on the same census, 19 year-old Theodore Barker of NJ is listed as a farm laborer with the family of George and Mary P. Lumbard. Jesse Barker married Isadore Shurts, daughter of David and Adaline Shurts. The 1850 Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists the family of Peter P. and Effey Shurts, whose children included 14 year-old David and 6 year-old William. Peter and Effey moved to Wheatland Twp., Bureau Co., IL by 1860, and sons David and William, as well as other children, were with them. The William Schirtz with whom Jessey Barker lived in 1880 was presumably Peter and Effey Shurts's son, as, apparently, was the David Shurts who was Isadore's father.

From 1900 to 1930, Jesse and Isadore Barker appear on Saratoga Twp., Marshall Co., IL censuses. In 1900, three children are listed for Jesse and Isadore: Elsie, Earnest, and Adaline. By 1910, Jesse and Isadore had another daughter, Margaret. In 1920, 83 year-old David Shurts, a widower identified as Jessie's father-in-law, lived with Jessie and Isadore. The 1930 census shows Jesse W. and Dora Barker with Ernest, who was 36 and single.

Notes for ISADORE SHURTS:

Isadora Shurts appears as Isadora Church on the 1870 Wheatland Twp., Bureau Co., IL census, where she is listed with her parents David and Adaline Church. The 1880 Milo Twp., Bureau Co., IL census lists 12 year-old Dora Shurts with David and Adaline Shurts, both of whom were born in NJ.

David Shurts was most likely the son of Peter P. Shurts and Effie Tiger, who were married 19 Dec 1835 in Hunterdon Co., NJ, and who moved from Tewksbury Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ to Wheatland Twp., Bureau Co., IL by 1860. Among their children listed on the 1860 census were 23 year-old David and 17 year-old William, both of whom were born in NJ. By 1870, David married Adaline, and by 1880, William married Eliza. After his father's death, Theodore and his brother, William Jesse, apparently moved to IL. The 1880 Saratoga Twp., Mashall Co., IL census lists 19 year-old Theodore Barker with the family of George and Mary P. Lombard. The 1880 census-taker states Theodore was single and born in NJ, as were his parents.

The 1900 Milo Twp., Bureau Co., IL census shows Dora and Nellie Barker, who had been married 13 years, with five children: Ross H., twins Gertrude and Gladys, and twins Scott and Hattie. (The census-taker states Dora was born Dec 1859.) By 1910, the family moved to Badger Twp., Davison Co., SD, where Theodore S. and Nellie Barker appear from 1910 to 1930.

The South Dakota Death Index lists Theodore S. Barker, who died in Davison Co. on 4 Mar 1942.

Notes for NELLIE AUSTIN:

The 1880 Milo Twp., Bureau Co., IL census lists 16 year-old Nellie Austin with her parents, Scott and Harriet Austin, and her siblings. The same family appears on the 1870 Milo Twp. census as Walter and Harriet Austin, and Nellie is listed as Susan. An IGI posting on the LDS site states Susan Ellen Austin was born 28 Sep 1863 in Milo Twp. and married Theodore S. Barker on 29 Dec 1886 in Princeton, Bureau Co., IL. Irma's surname is tentatively recorded here as Hoffman. The 1930 Califon, Hunterdon Co., NJ census lists Frank D. Moore's wife as 40 year-old Irma H. (In 1920 she is recorded as 31 years old.) The 1910 North Plainfield, Somerset Co., NJ census lists Chas. and Ellen Everitt, whom the census-taker states had been married one year. By 1920, Charles S. and Ellen Everitt had moved to Plainfield, Union Co., NJ and had two daughters, Mildred J. and Mary L. The family lived at 247 West Front St., sharing a house with

Edmond and Minnie Stephenson. Edmond and Charles were machinists at printing presses. In 1930, Charles and his family lived at 538 East Second St., Plainfield.

I and W.W. II draft registration cards offer different birth dates. The earlier card states Jacob L. Landon was born 22 Jun 1894 in New Germantown, and the later card states Jacob M. Landon was born 22 Jun 1892 in Oldwick. Since the census is the earliest record, the 1893 date is used here. The earlier registration card states Jacob was married and had a 2 year-old child. The later card lists Mattie Hattman of Burnt Mills, NJ, as a contact person.

The 1930 Readington Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ census places Jacob and Della Landon in Whitehouse Station. They had five children, and the census-taker indicates they had been married 12 years.

Notes for DELLA:

The S.S.D.I. lists Della Landon who was born 10 Aug 1899 and died 24 Jan 1993, and whose last residence was Neshanic Station, Somerset Co., NJ. Assuming this Della Landon was Jacob Landon's wife, the S.S.D.I. information has been entered here.

Mattie Hatman is tentatively entered here as Abraham and Mary Landon'd daughter. (Burnt Mills is in Bedminster Twp., Somerset Co., NJ.)

Notes for JOHN S. HATMAN:

John Hatman's W.W. I and W.W. II draft registration cards state he was born 23 Jan 1887 in Mestkovveh, Russia. The earlier card locates him in Whitehouse Station, NJ and the later card in Bedminster Twp., NJ. Census records show John and Mattie Hatman and state John was born in Russia and came to this country 1907.
