Descendants of Nicholas Everett

Generation 1

NICHOLAS¹ EVERETT. He died in 1819. He married MARTHA.

Notes for Nicholas Everett:

Nicholas Everett of Hillsborough Twp., Somerset Co., NJ died intestate, and administration of his estate was granted to Ezekiel Everett (of Bucks Co., PA), Benaiah Everett, and Peter Ditmars on 6 Nov 1819 (Bk.AB, p.195). Henry McCohn and Nicholas Williamson were the appraisers of Nicholas's estate. The inventory includes a reference to "John Everet, dec'd," Nicholas's son.

Nicholas Everett's ancestry is unknown, but documents offer clues. He seems to have been related to Nicholas Everitt of Jamaica, Queens Co., NY, born 31 Aug 1733 and died 17 Sep 1807. In his Last Will and Testament, written 24 Aug 1805 and proved 24 Oct 1807, Nicholas Everitt [spelled Everit, as on his Prospect Cemetery tombstone] names his wife, Elizabeth [née Smith], and identifies his sons as Benjamin Everitt, Wait Everitt, Othniel Everitt, and the late Nicholas Everitt. His daughters were Judith, wife of Daniel Ludlum, Jr., and Sarah, wife of Platt Smith, Jr. The late son, Nicholas Everitt, had a widow, Phebe. Their children were Nicholas Smith Everitt and Prescilla Everitt. Sarah and Platt Smith, Jr. had a son, Benjamin Smith. Also mentioned in the will was niece Prescilla Smith, daughter of deceased Nicholas Smith. Benjamin Everitt, Wait Everitt, and Othniel Everitt were named executors. Witnesses were Walter Smith, Samuel Mills, and Benjamin Everitt (Queens Co. Real Estate Wills, Vol. C, pp.27-30).

Three Somerset Co., NJ Mortgage Deeds document the conveyance of lots in Hillsborough Twp. by Nicholas and Martha Everitt to Nicholas Everitt, Sr. of Jamaica, Queens Co., NY in consideration of securing money, due bond. Witnesses to the first one, dated Apr 1798, were Waite Smith Everitt and John Everitt (Bk. E, p.233). The second, dated May 1802, was witnessed by Israel Everett and Nicholas Everett, Jr. (Bk. F, p.145). The third, dated Apr 1804, was witnessed by James Stryker and William Lou. The deed states that Nicholas Everett would take up a certain bond dated 1 May 1803 for the payment of twelve hundred pounds New York currency plus interest due to Nicholas Everett (Bk.F, p.357). A fourth deed also exists (Bk.F, p.270).

On 2 Feb 1824, the Chancery Court of New Jersey ruled in favor of Benjamin Everit, Othniel Everit, and Wait Everit who, as executors of the late Nicholas Everit of Jamaica, Queens Co., NY, whose Last Will and Testament was proved 24 Oct 1807, filed a suit after the death of Nicholas Everett of Hillsborough Twp., Somerset Co., NJ, in which they argued that Nicholas Everett of Hillsborough Twp., on or about 16 October 1804 owned several tracts of land, and that "being in want of money did apply to the said Nicholas Everitt of Jamaica" and "requested him to lend and advance . . . the sum of twelve hundred pounds New York currency, being equal to and of the value of three thousand dollars." [The amount cited in the deed dated 16 Apr 1804, which states Nicholas Everett was "to truly pay" this amount to Nicholas Everett of Jamaica and "take up a certain bond for the payment" (Bk.F, p.357).] They now asked payment from Ezekiel Everitt, Beniah Everitt, and Eliza (Everitt) Ditmars, widow of Peter Ditmars. Beniah Everitt was subsequently evicted from the disputed property.

Exactly how Nicholas Everett of Hillsborough was related to Nicholas Everett of Jamaica in unknown, but he may have been a grandson not mentioned in the 1805 Last Will and Testament of Nicholas Everett of Jamaica.

For the record, there were other Nicholas Everitts in Jamaica, Queens Co., NY:

- 1) Nicholas Everitt's Last Will and Testament, written 5 June 1723 and proved 26 May 1724, identifies his wife as Elizabeth and his children as Nicholas, Joseph, Richard, John, Samuel, Priscilla, Mary, Patience, Hannah, and Rachel. He writes "to my sons Samuel and John, both of Hopewell, New Jersey, all my lands and tenements in Hopewell."
- 2) Nicholas Everitt's Last Will and Testament, written 22 Oct 1748, identifies his wife as Elizabeth and his children as John, Ezekiel, Daniel, Sarah, Patience, Elizabeth, Judith, and Mary. Nicholas's grandchildren were Nicholas, Benjamin, Nehemiah, Phebe, and Elizabeth.
- 3) Also, a Nicholas Everitt of Hopewell, NJ, died intestate, and on 20 May 1727, administration of his estate was granted to his wife, Phebe. Samuel Green and Henry Oxley were the appraisers of the estate.

Further research is obviously needed to determine if any link exists between these

Nicholases and the Hillsborough Nicholas.

Nicholas Everett and Martha had the following children:

Notes for John Everett:

Administration of John Everett's estate was granted to Nicholas Everett and Martha Everett on 13 Aug 1816 (AB 143).

- iii. ELIZA EVERETT was born on 04 Dec 1788 in Somerset Co., NJ. She died on 31 Mar 1878 in Geneva, Seneca Co., NY (Lake View Cemetery, Interlaken, Seneca Co., NY). She married PETER DITMARS. He was born on 31 Mar 1785 in Millstone, Somerset Co., NJ. He died on 20 Apr 1869 in Geneva, Seneca Co., NY (Lake View Cemetery, Interlaken, Seneca Co., NY).
- 4. iv. Benaiah Everett was born on 23 Apr 1786. He died on 29 Nov 1863. He married Ann Van Arsdale. She was born on 03 Oct 1786. She died on 29 Nov 1863.

Generation 2

 EZEKIEL² EVERETT (Nicholas¹). He died (Forest Grove Presbyterian Cemetery, Buckingham, Bucks Co., PA). He married Sarah Stryker, daughter of Christopher Stryker and Judith Lorn, on 24 Sep 1804 in the Readington Dutch Reformed Church (Rev. Peter Studdiford). She died (Forest Grove Presbyterian Cemetery, Buckingham, Bucks Co., PA).

Notes for Ezekiel Everett:

Two documents identify Ezekiel Everett's wife as Sarah: Richard C. Everett's 1853 marriage record; and, an 1830 deed documenting Ezekiel and Sarah Everett's sale of 52 acres in Amwell Twp. to Richard Rounsavell (Bk.48, p.511).

Ezekiel Everett appears on the tax list of Hillsborough Twp., Somerset Co., NJ for 1805 and 1806. He first appears on census records in 1820, at which time he was living in Solebury Twp., Bucks Co., PA. His household contained 2 males 0-10 years old, 2 males 10-16, 1 male 16-26, 1 male 20-45, 2 females 0-10, 2 females 10-16, 1 female 16-18, 1 female 16-28, and 2 females 45 or more. The 1830 census locates Ezekiel in Amwell Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ. That year his household contained 1 male 5-10, 2 males 15-20, 2 males 20-30, 1 male 40-50, 2 females 10-15, 1 female 15-20, 1 female 20-30, and 1 female 40-50.

Ezekiel and Sarah, therefore, were born between 1780 and 1790 and may have had five sons and five daughters. The records of the Neshanic Reformed Church, however, list only eight children for Ezekiel and Sarah Everett ("Somerset County Historical Quarterly," Vol. 2, pp.60-61). Whether Ezekiel and Sarah had other children after their move to PA is not definite. The birth dates of the church records occasionally differ from those of other sources. The church's dates have been used here since they would have been the earliest records.

Deed records show that in 1834 Ezekiel, of Amwell Twp., sold 142 acres in Solebury Twp. (land near Joseph Carver and Garret Carver) to Christopher S. Everett. The deed notes that this was the same property Ezekiel acquired in 1826. A deed record for Ezekiel in Solebury Twp. earlier than 1826 has not yet been found, but records show that in 1824 Ezekiel had purchased ten acres in Lambertville, Hunterdon Co., NJ from Oliver Hamton. Ezekiel owned a lot of land in Lambertville which he apparently began acquiring in 1824. In 1828 he purchased property from John Coryell on the corner of York St. and Gordon's Alley. The deed states Ezekiel was from Solebury Twp. and that the property adjoined two houses "lately erected by Ezekiel Everit and Kenneth H. Fish." Ezekiel's Lambertville purchases and sales continued into the 1830s. Court records document that Ezekiel became a debtor. Nicholas Everett sued Ezekiel, and a document dated 24 Mar 1834 reads, in part: "I, Ezekiel Everitt, of the Township of Amwell . . . in and by a certain Bond bearing even the date herewith, do stand bound unto Nicholas Evereitt of the same

place in the penal sum of four thousand two hundred dollars" The document states that if Ezekiel "shall pay or cause to be paid to the above named Nicholas Everitt . . . the sum of two thousand and sixtyfive dollars and ninety cents . . . then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue." In 1835, Ezekiel transferred all of his estate by deed of assignment to Emley Holcombe and John Hoppock in trust for his creditors. Ezekiel's property was advertised in newspapers and described as a brick dwelling and store room on York St.; eleven acres on the east branch, and eleven acres on the south branch of Swan Creek; eight acres "on the mountain, two and a half miles from Lambertville"; about nine acres three miles from Lambertville on old Rock Rd., adjoining John Phillips and others; ten acres also near Rock Rd. adjoining Samuel Wilson and others; and, five acres near Rock Rd. adjoining Joseph Ramer. The sale was advertised for 20 Jul 1835. Deed records indicate some of this property was sold to Nicholas Everett.

Notes for Sarah Stryker:

William S. Stryker, in his "Genealogical Record of the Stryker Family," states that Christopher Stryker (1756-1826) married Judith Lorn (1756-1830) on 1 Dec 1746. They had six children: Dennis, Sarah, Hannah, Rachel, Garret, and Judith. They lived in Readington Twp., Hunterdon Co., though some of the children later moved into Somerset Co.

Peter Stryker (1762-1827) of Kingwood Twp., Hunterdon Co, who married Keziah Davis (1768-1828), was related to the Readington Strykers. Two of his children, Samuel D. and James D., lived in Lambertville about the same time Ezekiel and Sarah were in Lambertville. Samuel and James were lumber merchants, while Ezekiel appears to have been in the construction business. Whether the two knew each other and did business together is unknown.

Ezekiel Everett and Sarah Stryker had the following children:

She married James Craven Cornell, son of Adrian Cornell and Eleanor Craven, in 1825. He was born on 21 Sep 1804. He died on 01 Feb 1865 in Bucks Co., PA (Union Cemetery, Richboro, Bucks Co., PA).
 - MARTHA VAN CLIEF EVERETT was born on 23 Aug 1807. She married Wilson Tyson on 26 Jan 1831 in in the Lambertville Presbyterian Church (Rev. Peter O. Studdiford).
- 6. iii. NICHOLAS EVERETT was born on 15 Oct 1809. He died on 15 Jan 1860 in Portland, ME. He married Julia Ann Marbacher, daughter of John G. Marbacher, on 13 Nov 1839 in (Rev. J. M. Rogers). She was born in 1820.

She married Peter S. Vanderveer on 29 Oct 1835 in Lambertville, Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Peter O. Studdiford, Presbyterian Church).
- vii. Julian Vanhorn Everett was born on 01 Aug 1818. She married Holcomb Britton on 25 Apr 1838 in the Lambertville Presbyterian Church (Rev. Peter O. Studdiford). He was born in 1815.
- 10. viii. RICHARD D. COENSON EVERETT was born on 31 Jan 1822 in Bucks Co., PA. He died on 17 Oct 1866 (Barber Cemetery, Delaware Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ). He married (1) ACHSAH L. HOPPOCK, daughter of William L. Hoppock and Jane Heed, on 14 Dec 1841 in the Presbyterian Church, Lambertville, Hunterdon Co., NJ (Rev. Peter O. Studdiford). She was born on 04 Dec 1818. She died on 15 Aug 1851 (Barber Cemetery, Delaware Twp., Hunterdon Co., NJ). He married (2) ANNA GILL CARVER, daughter of Joel Carver and Lydia, on 20 Sep 1853 in in the Presbyterian Church, Doylestown, PA (Rev. Silas M. Andrews). She was born in 1824. She died on 16 Nov 1897.

Notes for Peter Ditmars:

Peter and Eliza Ditmars are found on the I850 NY census living in Covert, Seneca Co. With them are their children: Nicholas, Catharine, and Abram. In 1860 the family was in Seneca, Ontario Co., NY.

Some of the information presented here for Peter and Eliza Ditmar's children comes from family trees posted at Rootsweb.com by Angel Stonecypher and by "Cynthia."

Notes for Nicholas Everett:

Nicholas's marriage was announced in the 29 Nov 1839 edition of the "Easton Sentinel": "Married: On the 13th inst. by the Rev. J.M. Rogers, Mr. Nicholas Everitte, of Lambertsville, N.J., to Miss Julia A., daughter of the late John G. Marbacher, of this place." The 1840 Amwell Twp. census shows Nicholas Everett with a household containing one male and female 20-30 years old, one male 30-40, and one female 40-50. The identities of the older male and female are unknown.

Between 1840 and 1850, Nicholas and Julia (Marbacher) Everett had a daughter and moved to Easton, PA. The 1850 census shows Nicholas, Julia, and daughter Mary living with a 71 year-old Elizabeth Marbacher.

Nicholas's death was reported in a Lambertville newspaper of Wed., 18 Jan 1860. Nicholas, "formerly of this place, but more recently of Portland, Maine," was injured on Saturday the 14th and died the next day. A fuller account appeared on 25 Jan 1860: "The circumstances attending the death of Capt. Nicholas Everitt, formerly a resident of Hunterdon Co., are briefly these: He was employed upon the Grand Trunk Railroad in the capacity of road master, and his duties often called him away from home, as was the case upon Saturday, 14th inst. To return to Portland he had taken passage upon a freight train, and in passing from a flat car to the tender of the engine, slipped and fell under the train. He was picked up and taken to a house nearby, where it was found the brake shafts, in their passage over him, had broken his right arm and left leg as well as giving him some severe bruises in the breast. He survived the accident exactly twelve hours, remaining perfectly sensible the while. He was interred at Portland on Wednesday, 18th inst. He leaves a wife and one daughter to mourn his sudden demise."

Notes for Julia Ann Marbacher:

The 1880 Philadelphia, PA census shows a 60 year-old widow, Julia Everett, living with her sister, Mary A. Woodruff, at 137 Thirteenth St. The Philadelphia City Directory of 1890 lists Julia Everett, widow of Nicholas, at 1535 Spring Garden St.

Notes for Christopher Stryker Everett:

Christoper S. Everett's death record was found at the Court House in Dolyestown, PA. His name was listed as: Everett, C. Stryker. He died 14 Aug 1894, was 83 years old, lived in New Hope, and was buried in Forest Grove Cemetery on 17 Aug 1894.

Christopher's Will (Bk.26, p.456) was written 7 Sep 1893 and proved 24 Sep 1894. Christopher instructed that he should be buried at Forest Grove Cemetery. Names mentioned in the Will were his grandson, A. Walton Everett and his wife, Kate; granddaughter Annie R. Carver; and Nellie, Laura, and Walter Carver [children of Annie R. and Emmor Carver]. A. Walton Everett was appointed executor, and witnesses were Andrew J. Solomon and Richard C. Foulke.

Orphans' Court records show that A. Walton Everett petitioned the court to sell Christopher's New Hope property to pay Christopher's debts. The court approved the sale of the property to Jordan Shaffer for \$1255.00.

Notes for Ann:

The announcement of Ann Everett's death appeared in the "Bucks County Intelligencer" of 4 Sep 1839 and stated that Ann died at age 24. Her birth year has been calculated from this information.

Notes for Julian Vanhorn Everett:

The 1840 Amwell Twp. census shows Holcomb Britton living near Samuel D. Stryker and Nicholas Everett. Holcomb's household included 1 male 0-5 years old, 2 males 20-30, 1 male 50-60, 1 female 10-15, and 1 female 20-30. The identity of the older male is unknown. Between 1840 and 1850 Holcomb and Julia moved to Cecil Co., Maryland. The 1850 Cecil Co. census lists Jas. L. Britton (43), Holcomb (35), Julianna V. (31), and Samuel (3). By 1860, another son, James, was added to the family.

Holcomb Britton and Julian Vanhorn Everett had the following children:
