temperate family;— used no tobacco nor intoxicants in any form whatever. They were great readers, and always found time for the reading of useful books. Naomi was an advocate of woman's suffrage, but did not live to realize her ardent desires. She was called to her final rest Jan. 3rd, 1892, aged seventy-seven years. Her husband died January 3rd, 1888, at the age of ninety-one.
