In pursuance of your order to me directed dated <sup>the 20<sup>th</sup> day</sup> of July 1749 ordering me for to survey to and for Thos. Ford the Quant of one hundred acres of Land any where below the falls of Delaware etc. In pursuance whereof I have Surveyed the Land unto the sd Thos. Ford lying on the New Road to Little Egg Harbor on the East side of wading River and is bounded as followeth viz Beginning at a pine tree bounded in the Line of Stephen Leeks Land and runs from the N. North twenty five rods East twenty five chains to a pine then South Sixty rods East forty five chains to a pine then South twenty four rods West thirty chains to a pine then North thirty five rods West twenty one to a post then by the Land of Stephen Leek North seventy rods West twenty five chains to the corner pine first mentioned Surveyed for one hundred acres with allowance for high ways
