of so one Hundred acres of Land in two Lots lying Situate

of westerly side of so River up a certain Branch called  
Shocheague of first Lott Being Cedar Swamp lying ~~adjoining~~  
adjoining in of afove so Branch on of Southerly side of a lot  
of cedar Swamp formerly Surveyed to Nathaniel Cripps but now  
is in of possession of so Thomas and David and Elijah Clark

Beginning at a pine tree mark on four sides for a corner by of side  
of so cedar Swamp and Runs thence first North twelve Deg  
East five Chane to a cedar in of Cripps thence Secondly  
along in of line of so Cripp North eighty four Deg West  
Twenty Chane to a cedar for a corner thence leaving Cripps line  
thirdly South twelve Deg West ~~and of so Swamp and so up so~~  
Branch ten sixteen Chane to a pine for a corner thence fourthly East  
four Chane crossing so small Branch to a cedar for a corner thence fifthly

one Deg East fifteen Chane to a cedar for a corner thence  
fourthly South across of Branch four Chane to of first mentioned  
pine containing five acres & ~~one tenth~~ <sup>one tenth</sup> of an acre strict measure  
Both Lots maketh Twenty acres strict measure after Allowance  
for Highways leaves Nineteen acres Chain Barers were
