Little Eggharbour in the County of Burlington April 28<sup>th</sup> 1757

In pursuance of an order to me directed bearing Date the twenty fourth Day of January Anno 1757 ordering me to Survey unto John Ridgway of Little Eggharbour of full Quantity of Ninety one acres of Land in any parte Unappropriated in the Western Division of New Jersey below the falls of Talloway River. Therefore I have Surveyed unto D John Ridgway of Quantity of Thirteen acres of Land parte of D Ninety one acres Situated in Little Eggharbour abov<sup>e</sup> about one mile and a quarter to the Eastward of the East Side of said River up a certain Branch or Run commonly called by the Name of Ashetamens Run that Enters it self into said River abov<sup>e</sup> and up the Branch above the Ruins of David Gates Sub mill near a mile Eastward Beginning at the Westerly End of a group of young cedar poles at a pine by the Southerly End of the Branch marked on four sides Lettered C for a corner and Extends thence (1<sup>st</sup>) North Sixty five Deg<sup>r</sup> East five Chain & fifty Links to a post thence (2<sup>nd</sup>) East Thirty five Chain up the Run to a post thence (3<sup>rd</sup>) North Sixty five Deg<sup>r</sup> East three Chain & fifty Links in the Bend of the Branch to a post for a corner thence (4<sup>th</sup>) North ten Deg<sup>r</sup> East three Chain & fifty Links to a post standing in pine meadow land for a corner thence (5<sup>th</sup>) North Sixty five Deg<sup>r</sup> East sixteen Chain to a cedar for a corner thence (6<sup>th</sup>) North Thirty five Deg<sup>r</sup> East five Chain to a pine mark on four sides for a corner thence crossing the Run amongst young cedar poles (7<sup>th</sup>) North Eighty Deg<sup>r</sup> West Two Chain & ten Links to a post thence down the Run (8<sup>th</sup>) South Sixty five Deg<sup>r</sup> West three Chain & fifty Links to a post thence (9<sup>th</sup>) South Sixty five Deg<sup>r</sup> West sixteen Chain to a post thence (10<sup>th</sup>) South ten Deg<sup>r</sup> West four Chain and thirty Links to a post in the crook of the Run for a corner thence (11<sup>th</sup>) West Thirty Six Chain & fifty Links to a post thence (12<sup>th</sup>) South Sixty five Deg<sup>r</sup> West six Chain & fifty Links to a post thence (13<sup>th</sup>) South forty one Deg<sup>r</sup> East Two Chain & ten Links to a first mentioned pine containing thirteen acres & two tenths of an acre strict measure of Ciple and cedar swamp which after allowance for high ways leaves twelve acres and five tenth parts of an acre or my chain bases were 98 m<sup>r</sup> Gorffet & John Leek Juner Surveyor
