In pursuance of an order to me directed bearing date 14th Day of April 1759 ordering me to survey a quantity of two hundred acres of land in any or several Townships of New Jersey Below the River Delaware. Therefore I have surveyed to of Jonathan Hough of above Sixty acres including seven acres that was surveyed for Wm. Rogers in 3rd Township of Little Egg Harbor about 90 chains to the Eastward of the East Side of Wading River Beginning at a pine tree standing about one chain above the ruins of an old mill on Ahatamans Run Double marked on four sides it being a corner to a survey formerly made to Wm. Rogers and from thence it extends North Thirty Eight Deg. west crossing of Phil. Road twelve chains to a pine tree then (2) North fifteen Deg. west nine chains to another pine corner to of Wm. Rogers marked on 4 sides with a Blaz. letter H and IL (3) and from thence in a line of Wm. Rogers North twenty eight Deg. East sixteen chains to Rogers corner pine tree standing in flat land then (4) North thirty three Deg. west nine chains to a pine tree then (5) North Deg. East sixteen chains to a pine by the East side of Bevers Run for a corner then (6) South forty nine chains & sixty links Sam. Arnall and Ahatamans & Christopher and Middle Bridge Runs then (7) North sixty nine Deg. West six chains to a post across Middle Bridge Run in a line of Rogers survey then (8) North fifteen Deg. west in a line of Rogers survey crossing two runs to of Beginning pine tree containing sixty acres including 3 of Wm. Rogers seven acres and 3 of allowance for highways leaves fifty acres and one Rod my Chain Barre Jonathan Hough & Peter Allen Survey for me John Leck Dep.
