of may anno Dom 1759 ordering me to Survey to Robt. Morris
& William Bonnett in Company w^t full Quantity of Six hundred
Acres in any part of Unappropriated Land in the western Division of
New Jersey Below y^t falls of Delaware River Therfor I have Surveyed
at above four acres & four tenth parts of an acre to Robt. Morris & Bonnett
Situate in that part of Great Egg Harbor that lyeth up y^t Northwesterly
main branch of Cedar Creek about one mile above Morris's Sawmill
Beginning at a cedar by y^t Southerly side of a slip of Green Cedar Swamp
and Extends ¹ North Seventy Deg East Down y^t Swamp Twenty Two
to Two Cedars for a corner in Brent swamp Then ² North Twenty Deg West
Three Chains Crossing y^t Swamp to a post Then ³ South Seventy Deg West
Twenty Two Chains to a post up y^t Branch Then ⁴ South Twenty Deg East
one Chain to ⁵ Beginning Cedar & containing four acres and one Rod
Beside allowance for Road chain bares Robt. Morris & Wm Bonnet Surveyor
