By Virtue of a Warrant from the Council of Proprietors to the Surveyor General &c. — I have Survey'd unto James Bell the following Described Tract of Land & Salt Marsh Situate in the Township of Galloway, in the County of Gloucester, and Western Division of the State of New Jersey and lies Adjoining on the North Side of Mearitt Creek and also on the South west end of a Resurvey Made by John Leek on the 19<sup>th</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> Days of March 1761 for Joseph Johnson Containing three Hundred & seventy five Acres and is Recorded in the Surveyor General's Office in Burlington in Libra K folio 206 &c. — And is bounded as follows Beginning at the third Corner of said Resurvey being a Stake standing by the edge of said Creek just below the <sup>lower</sup> Ferry, about three Chains & twenty five links below the Ferry Ditch and Runs from thence in the Southwest line of said Resurvey [1<sup>st</sup>] North fifty Degrees West thirty six Chains to a corner. then [2<sup>nd</sup>] South fifty two Degrees, & fifty five Minutes West. ten Chains to a corner. then [3<sup>rd</sup>] South forty one Degrees & fifteen Minutes East Fifteen Chains & fifty links to a ~~stake~~. then [4<sup>th</sup>] South sixty three Degrees West five Chains, and ninety links to a corner. then [5<sup>th</sup>] South twelve Degrees West. four Chains & seventy five links to a corner stake. then [6<sup>th</sup>] South sixty four Degrees & fifteen Minutes East three Chains and ninety five links. then [7<sup>th</sup>] South forty four Degrees & fifteen Minutes East six Chains and a half. then [8<sup>th</sup>] South fifty nine Degrees East. two Chains and a half. then [9<sup>th</sup>] North sixty seven Degrees & a half East twenty Chains. then [10<sup>th</sup>] North sixty one Degrees East three Chains and fifty links to the place of Beginning. Containing Fifty three Acres and the usual Allowance for Highways. —

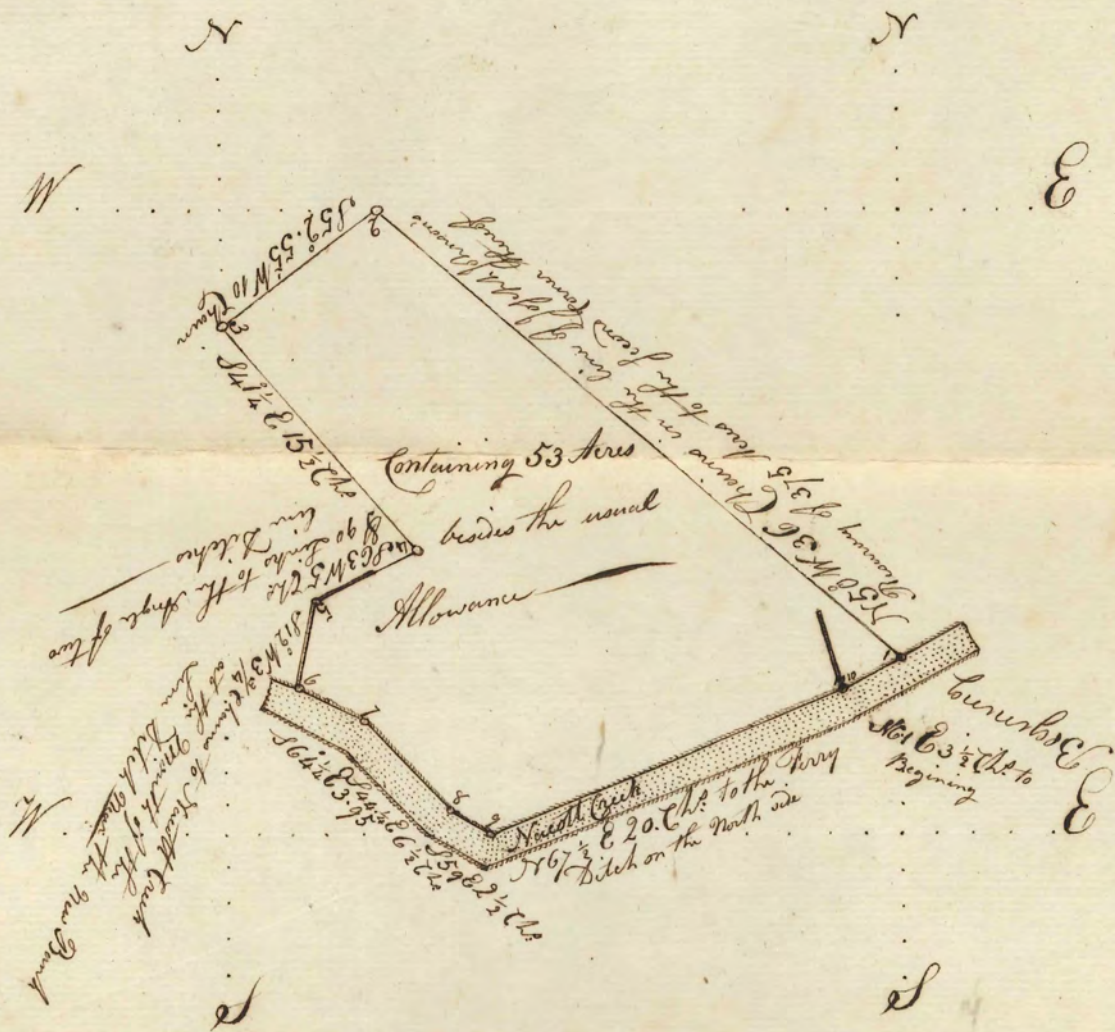
