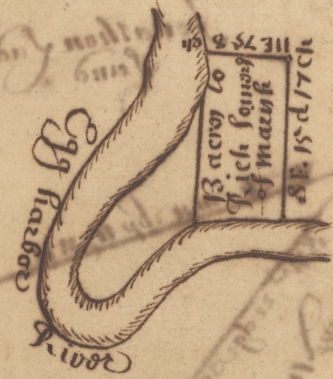
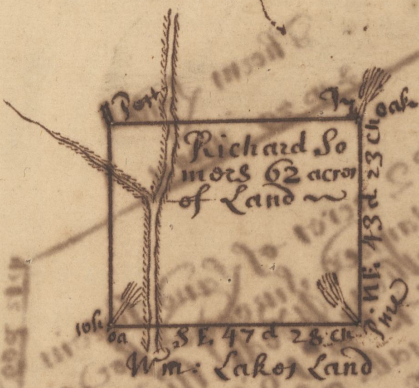




Whereas Hugh Sharp ordered me to survey forth of his Warrant in my hands unto Richard Somers y^e Quantity of 232 acres of Land y^e order Bearer Date y^e 1st of December 1716 In Pursuance whereof I have Surveyed the follow^{ing} Parcels of Land & marsh - Part thereof within y^e County of Gloucester at Great Egg Harbor the first - Lying on y^e East Side thereof near y^e head of a Branch called y^e Back Creek or Lakes Creek Beginning at a White oak on y^e Northerly Side thereof from thence South Eastwardly forty seven dgs Crossing y^e 1st Creek & running by y^e bounds of Lakes Land thence North Eastwardly forty three dgs twenty three chains to a Rod - oak then North Westwardly forty seven dgs twenty eight chains to a Post then South Westwardly forty three dgs twenty three chains to y^e Place of Beginning Containing Sixty five acres besides allowance for high way or Surveyed by me Rich: Bull

The second being a Parcel of Marsh is situate on y^e Westwardly Side of Egg Harbor River beginning at a Post by y^e Side of y^e 1st River from thence South Eastward by fifteen dgs seven dgs to another Post in y^e marsh then North Eastwardly seven dgs eight chains to a Post by y^e 1st River then North Westwardly fifteen dgs seven dgs chain past by y^e River & that across a neck of marsh to another Post by the River then up the same to y^e beginning Containing thirteen acres both parcels Surveyed October y^e nineteenth 1717 by me Richard Bull

Entered upon Record the 4th of y^e first mo anno Domini 1719 being first allowed by the Council of Proprietors by me Tho: Sharp
