

He died May 14, 1823, and his widow, Sarah, was living in Jackson Township, Monmouth County, New Jersey, in May, 1844, aged seventy-eight years.

In January, 1846, their son, Herchiah D., was fifty-four years of age and was living in Monmouth County, New Jersey.

There are no further data on file relative to the descendants of Joseph Smith.






