Age 0 — Birth

Oct 1801 • Washington County, New York, USA

Discrepancy as to his mother. "The Dead They Speak" and History of Herkimer County say Sarah Gardinier/Gordinier. His death record says Mary Gardner, but Mary Gardner may have been born AFTER Isaac, unless this is a different Mary Gardner.

Age 11 — Residence

Came to Herkimer County from Washington County, NY

Age 24 — Residence

1825 • UNKNOWN

In 1825 NY State Census, in Herkimer Co., I find no Lakes in Warren, but I do find Gardners, Starkweather, and Tredway. Charles Lake in Frankfort, Asa Lake in Salisbury.

Age 29 — Residence

1830 • UNKNOWN

In 1830 U.S. Census, there are Lakes in Herkimer and Otsego Counties, but no Abram, William, or Isaac. There is a Henry Lake in Otsego County.

Age 34 — Residence

1835 • UNKNOWN

In 1835 NY State Census, in Herkimer Co., I find no Lakes in Warren, but I do find Gardners, Starkweather, and Tredway. Jarvis Lake in Little Fall, Charles Lake in Frankfort. Are Lakes in neighboring Otsego County? 1835 Otsego Co. NY State Census missing.

Age 39 — Residence

1840 • UNKNOWN

I cannot locate an Isaac Lake in Herkimer County in 1840. There are other Lakes in Herkimer and Otsego, but no Isaac, William, or Abram.

Age 48 — Residence

6 Aug 1850 • Warren, Herkimer, New York, United States

Includes Sarah as his wife. Starkweather and Treadway also in Warren

Age 54 — Residence

1855 • Warren, New York, USA

Includes S. W. Lake as his wife.

1859 • Jordanville, Warren, Herkimer County, New York, United States of America

I. Lake noted on 1859 map of Jordanville

Age 59 – Residence

1860 • Warren, Herkimer County, NY

Occupation: Farmer. Sarah W. as wife. Residence Post Office: Jordanville. Starkweather also present.

Age 63 – Co-Executor of David Starkweather Will

21 Mar 1865 • Warren, Herkimer, New York

Age 64 – Residence

1865 • Warren, Herkimer, New York, USA

Includes Sarah W. his wife.

Age 68 – Residence

1869 • Jordanville, Warren, Herkimer, New York, USA

"Lake, Isaac, (Jordanville,) farmer 18." 18 refers to the number of acres farmed. Also in the edition is "Lake, Samuel, (Middleville), 1."

Age 69 – Residence

1870 • Warren, Herkimer, New York, USA

Living with Sarah W., his wife, Electa Starkweather age 70 and James E. Lake age 24. Isaac's mother and father are NOT marked as foreign born.

Age 70 – New Methodist Episcopal church of Jordanville

1871 • Jordanville, Warren, Herkimer County, New York, United States of America

Isaac Lake named as working toward the new building.

Age 74 – Residence

1875 • Warren, Herkimer, New York, USA

Living with Sarah W., his wife, James Edward Lake and his wife Ellen

Age 78 – Residence

25 Jun 1880 • Warren, Herkimer, New York, USA

Owns 17.5 acres

Age 85 – Death of wife Sarah W Treadway

Tredway (1803–1886)

31 Dec 1886 • Jordanville, Warren, Herkimer County, New York, United States of America

Age 85 – Residence

May 1887 • Truxton, Cortland, New York, USA

"...left in May 1887 for Truxton, New York, where he resided with his nephew, James Lake."

Age 90 – Will

14 Nov 1891 • Warren, Herkimer, New York, USA

As best I understand, the original will named James E. Lake as executor - Isaac bequeathed all to him. I believe James E. is Isaac's nephew. A codicil was added 17 April 1892 to have a farm in Marion go to the children of Isaac's nephew, Charles H. Lake.
