In the year of our Lord 1634 my honorable father Gerrit Remmersen was born in Oostvrieslandt in a village named Pilsum.

In the year of our Lord 1658 my honorable father jGerrit Remmersen arrived in this land at Amersfoort.

In the year of our Lord 1636 my honorable mother was born on Bermodus.

In the year of our Lord 1678 the 27th December my honorable father fell asleep in the Lord on a Tuesday in the Morning, and was buried in Stuyvesant's church aged about 44 years. [Samuel Garritsen] Gerrit Remmersen is a native of East Friesland in a village called Pilsum, Germany, Gerrit came to Amersfoort, America in 1656. 2nd husband of Mary (?) His daughters by wife Mary (1st husband Willem Gerritsen) all used the patronymic Gerritsen which became their surname. Papers in Brooklyn Historical Society Recorded by Samuel Gerritsen In 1 MAY 1678 Gerrit & Mary & family moved out of the Bay[Amersfoort or Flatlands] to York Island in a hamlet named Sapochanika [refers to Chelsea district of Manhattan]

Notes for Mary(Maria) Unkown:

Quote from the family bible:

In 1659 Mary and William Gerritsen arrived in New Netherland. In the year of our Lord 1685 the first of May my honorable mother removed with her family to Gravesant

In the year of our Lord 1678 the first of May my father and my mother with her family removed out of the bay to York Island to a hamlet named Sapochkanika. Quote: I.N. Phelps-Stokes in volume 6 of his "The Iconography of Manhattan Island" says that "Sapokanickan" was the name of the Indian village where Greenwich Village in Manhattan is today. End Quote:

Rem, s. of Gerrit Remmersen and Mary or Maria, of Gd, where he took the oath of allegiance in 1687 as a native. Resided in Cape May, N. J., in 1696. Signed his named Rem Gerretsen. Samuel (a. s. of Gerret and Mary Remmersen, or Gerret s. of Rem of Gd) m. Ida Barends. On ass. roll of Gd of 1693, cen. of 1698, and deeds of the same dates, as per pp. 175, 177, 182, and 183 of Lib. 2 of Con.; also clerk of the board of supervisors in 1703, and mem. of the colonial legislature from 1716 to 1737. Believe him to be the ancestor of the Gd family of Gerretsens, who owned a farm and the tide-mill in said town located on the Strome Kil, the boundary between Gd and Flds, known as Gerretsen's mill; and also of the late J. Fletcher Gerretsen and Judge Sam' Gerretsen of Brn and Thos Gerretsen of Flds. Issue:-- Ferdindandus, bp. Apl. 25, 1696, and other children. Signed his name "Samuel Gerretsen."

Remmersen or Remmertsz, Gerret, m. Mary or Maria ----. Both mem. of the R. D. ch of Flds in 1677, where he and his heirs owned land as late as 1697, as per deed on p. 117 of Lib. 2 of Con. Jan. 6, 1684, Mary Remmersen, residing on N. Y. Island, bought of John Tilton plantation-lot No. 30 with the buildings thereon in Gd, as per town rec. Jan. 17, 1698-9 Mary Remmersen of Gd receipts of L5 to R. Van Sicklen on an agreement made by her two sons Rem and Samuel Gerretse. In 1698 Mary wid. of Gerret Remmersen of Gd conveys to Samuel Gerretse her son a house and garden-spot in Gd, and also land on Gisbert's I. bounded on the one side by the sea, as per Gd rec. Gerret Remmersen means Gerret son of Rem; and Samuel Gerretse, Samuel son of Gerret. From this Samuel Gerretse is descended the late Gerretsen family of Brn, of whom the late John Fletch, Thomas, and Judge Samuel Gerretsen were members. No clue to the proper surname (if any) of this family has been found. Issue:--Rem Gerretse; and Samuel Gerretse, who m. Ida Barends. Made his mark on documents.
