6. The testimony of two or more witnesses who know the parties to have lived together as bushand and wife from the date of their allegad marriage, the witnesses stating the period during which they knew them thus to cobabit.

Witnesses under the 2d, 3d, 4th, and 0th classes of testimony must state the circumstances or cetemporaneous events by which they are enabled to fix the date of the marriage, and the witnesses should state their ages at the time they testify.

Before any of the lower classes of evidence can be accepted, it must be shown by competent testimony that none higher can be obtained.

If the claim is for service pension under the act of February 14, 1871, or March 9, 1878, proof will be required to show whether the claimant has again married since the death of the soldier on whose services the claim is made.
