WILTSIE	Minnie, eldest dau. of G. Fred and Fannie P., d. Nov. 12, 1875 ae 8.
PENNOYER	Mrs. Hannah Elizabeth b. Washingtonville, N. Y., d. no date (Apr. 15, 1918 written on obit) age in 97th year. Left 2 daus: Mrs. Fannie P. Wiltsie of South Orange and Mrs. Wallace Rowe of Valatie, N. Y. and 2 sons: William of Newburgh and Harry W. of New York City. Was widow of Henry M. Pennoyer and member of Baptist church.
PENoyer	(2nd obit) Harriet White Penoyer died in Warwick dau. of James White and Mary Wheeler of Washingtonville, N. Y. where she was born Aug. 24, 1821. Mother's parents were Gilbert and Ruth (Benedict)

Wheeler. Ruth was dau. of Elder James Benedict of Warwick. Harriet married Henry Merritt Penoyer in 1841 in Sanfordville. Henry M. Penoyer of French descent. They moved to Washingtonville and later to Valatie, Col. Co., N. Y. where 4 children born. Henry M. d. 1854. Mary (Wheeler) White owned Baird Tavern in Warwick where Gen. Washington was a guest. Children: Henry Wheeler Penoyer of New York City, William Wallace Penoyer of Newburgh, Mrs. Fannie P. Wiltsie of South Orange, N. J. and Mrs. Alice R. Roe of Valatie, N. Y. 3 Grandsons: Lieut. W. Culbert Lyon of Dallas, Texas, Lieut. W. B. Penoyer of Spartanburgh, S. C. and John R. Wiltsie of S. Orange, N. J. 1 Great-grandson: W. Culbert Lyon, Jr., an infant

JONES Hiram A. b. Bellvate, near Warwick, Oct. 1819, son of Nathaniel Jones (a state senator, engineer, and surveyer who married Mary Burt oldest dau. of late James of Warwick & they had 8 children: James B. of sub-treasury of New York City, Mrs. Seely Edwall of Unadilla, Nebr., Hiram A. (above) --- others not listed) Hiram A. was superintendent of schools 1864-1872 - went to Calif. - and returned a few years later. Traveled much in Europe. Married 1841 to Francis White. (rest of obit lists accomplishments of Hiram)

WHIPPLE Mrs. Mary S. Wiltsie-Whipple d. Aug. 9, 1907 at home of dau., Mrs. Bayard H. Tyler, 23 Dudley Place, Yonkers. She was born Gilmanton, N. H., Feb. 12, 1820, dau. of Rev. Luke A. Spofford. Married 1845 to John R. Wiltsie. She married 2nd 1887 to Rev. W. W. Whipple of Kansas. He died 1890.

Children: Arthur V. Wiltsie of New York City, Mrs. James T. Joslin of Williamsport, Pa., Mrs. William C. Belknap of Newburgh, Mrs. Bayer H. Tyler of Yonkers, Mrs. William H. Lake of New Rochelle. Brothers: Hon. Ainsworth R. Spofford of Washington, D. C. Cousin: Rev. W. Rand of Yonkers. She was a member of 1st Presby. Church of Yonkers, buried in Poughkeepsie.

LYON William H. b. Wykerstown, Sussex Co., N. J., died 30 Jan. 1900 ae 58. Native of Newburgh. Son of Samuel A. and Permelia Howell Cramer (She married 2nd a Mr. Patton.) Samuel A. Lyon d. in 1840's. Samuel's children: Charles W., M. E. Minister of Essex, Conn., Julia Ann, widow of Capt. Lauchlan Stewart and William H. (above) a watchmaker. William H. married Alice Pennoyer and had Culbert.

BELKNAP Mrs. Harriet W., widow of William C. Belknap, died Nov. 27, 1926. Her will is in probate: Executor: Mrs. Charlotte E. Tyler (sister) of Yonkers. Sister, Mrs. Laura S. Lake of Brooklyn. Nephews: John R. Wiltsie, A. Hurlburt Wiltsie, Ainsworth S. Lake, Henry R. Lake and John Wiltsie Lake. Nieces: Mary S. T. Fisher and Myra Joslin Tyler. Sister-in-law: Fanny P. Wiltsie.

BENEDICT Harriet Durland d. June 5, 1884 at Warwick, N. Y. age 41 yrs. 8 months and 27 days. Wife of Capt. James W. Benedict and dau. of Thomas E. Durland and Mary Ellen Booth all of Orange Co., N. Y. She was a descendant of Sarah Wells, first white woman in area. She was born Schuyler Co., Ill., where her mother died. At age 8 she returned to Orange Co.,

N. Y. Feb. 1866 married Capt. Benedict and lived in Missouri for 8 years, then back to Orange Co., N. Y. James E. Durland had 4 dau.s (Harriet was one.) and 1 son by 1st wife. He married 2nd to Mrs. Mary A. Wisner (who had 3 children) and they had 2 more children. Harriet and James Benedict had 6 children: 1 died young in Mo., 4 girls and a boy (not named in obit).

BENEDICT Mrs. Fanny died July 3, (no year) age 89 and 22 days. Was dau. of James Benedict who d. 1822 & grand dau. of Elder James Benedict (Baptist) from Stratford, Conn., 1765. Fanny married 1829 Jonathan Bell Benedict of New Canaan, Conn., who d. 1841. They had 2 sons; Capt. James W. survives her.

PENoyer Mrs. Susan, widow of H. W. Penoyer, who died in Masonic Home in Utica. Survived by nephews William B. Penoyer of Montgomery, N. Y., and John R. Wiltsie of S. Orange, N. J. Obit dated Feb. 2, 1928.

WHEELER James B. died Nov. 13, 1882 age 84 in Warwick. Born Nov. 15, 1798 near Sanfordville, only son of Gilbert Wheeler. Sisters: Mary, wife of James White, Harriet, wife of Joseph Roe, Emeline, wife of Robert Penoyer. James B. married Mary J. Mills and had 1 child, Mrs. Anna W. White. Wife and dau. survive him.

JOSLIN Mira Wiltsie, wife of late James T., died July 21, 1919 ae ? A 2nd obit added: Survived by sister, Mrs. William C. Belknap, sister Mars. Bayard H. Tyler of Yonkers, sister, Mrs. William H. Lake of Bay Ridge, N. Y., brother Arther V. Wiltsie of New York City. She was dau. of late John R. Wiltsie.

She was buried in Schenectady where her husband was buried 6 years ago.

LYON Lieut. Culbert, retired Navel surgeon, died Feb. 7 1822, at home of mother, Mrs. Wallace Rowe, in Bala-tie, N. Y. He was born in Newburgh 43 years ago. Survived by mother and 2 children in Galveston, Texas.

LYON William H., jeweler, died Jan. 30, 1900. Born in Newburgh, July 1841. Mother married 2nd to Thomas Patton. William married 1867 to Alice Penoyer who had a sister, Julia Stewart, widow of Capt. Lachlan Stewart, and brother: William W. Penoyer and sister Mrs. G. Fred Wiltsie. William had a son, William Culbert Lyon, and a dau. who died in 1874. Brother, Rev. Charles W. Lyon.

DUDLEY James H. died June 30, 1896, almost 79 years old. Died at home of son, Guilford; he was born in Separate, Stanford, July 14, 1817, a descendant of William Dudley, who settled Guilford, Conn., 1639, and of Gov. Leete. He married 1842 to Charlotte Wiltsie and they were married over 50 years. They had 2 boys and 2 girls.

DUDLEY Lavinia, dau. of James H. and Charlotte, died 2 Nov. 1892 at 46. Brother: Guilford.

CRABTREE Mrs. Cornelia, buried at Dundee; died Gainesville, Georgia, Thurs., of typhoid. Lived Elgin about 10 years. Husband, Dr. Crabtree, settled Dundee 50 years ago. Her only child, Ida, wife of Dr. Munson of Florida. Cornelia b. Nov. 2, 1830 in Dutchess Co., N. Y. Survived by 2 brothers:

J. C. Wiltsie and Abe Wiltsie, both of Dundee.

SUGDEN Nellie Day, dau. of late William Sugden and niece of
Henry S. Day, married Dec. 1, 1892 to Irving Longking
Wiltsie, son of late Abraham. They will live in Fanwood, N. J.
Attendants: cousin, Frank T. Day; brother, Erving Wiltsie; sister,
Nellie J. Sugden.

LAKE William Henry of N. Y. married Oct. 24, 1890 to Laura
Spofford Wiltsie, dau. of late John R. of Newburgh.

WILTSIE G. Fred - 2 of his children died of diptheria: Min-
nie d. Nov. 12, 1875 ae 8 and Nellie (Helen) d. Nov.
14, 1875 ae 3 yrs., 8 mo. and 27 days. All of Newburgh.

WILTSIE G. Fred d. 16 Feb. 1897 ae 56 - of Newburgh.

LYON William H. his dau., Hattie, died of diptheria Nov.
15, 1875 age 7 years, 1 mo. and 15 days. Hattie was
niece of G. Fred Wiltsie.

WHITE Mrs. Mary, died July 23, 1877 age 83 yrs. 8 months.

beth Wiltsie, dau. of John R. and Mary S. (dated
Oct. 3, 1886)

WHIPPLE W. W. of Norton, Kans., married Mrs. Mary S. Wiltsie
