WHEREAS *John Adams* of the County of *Philadelphia* hath requested to take up *One hundred and twenty five* Acres or Land, including an improvement on the western of *King's Creek* adjoining *land of* *Young's death and others* " " " " " "

in the County of *Washington* (PROVIDED the Land is not within the last Purchase made of the Indians) for which *he* agrees to pay, immediately, into the Office of the Receiver General, for the use of this State, at the rate of Ten Pounds per Hundred Acres, in Gold, Silver, Paper Money of this State, or Certificates, agreeable to an act of Assembly, passed the first day of April, 1784: Interest to commence from the *first day of March 1784* THESE are, therefore, to authorize and require you to survey, or cause to be surveyed, unto the said *John Adams* at the place aforesaid, according to the method of Townships appointed, the said quantity of Acres, if not already surveyed, or appropriated, and to make return thereof into the Secretary's Office, in order for confirmation; for which this shall be your Warrant.

IN WITNESS whereof *we* *George* *Wheatland* *Secretary* *of the* *Supreme Executive Council* *has* *signed* *for* *his* *agent* *and* *caused* *the* *great* *Seal* *of* *the* *said* *Commonwealth* *to* *be* *affixed* *the* *twenty* *first* *day* *of* *February* *in* *the* *year* *1784* *D.* *C.*
