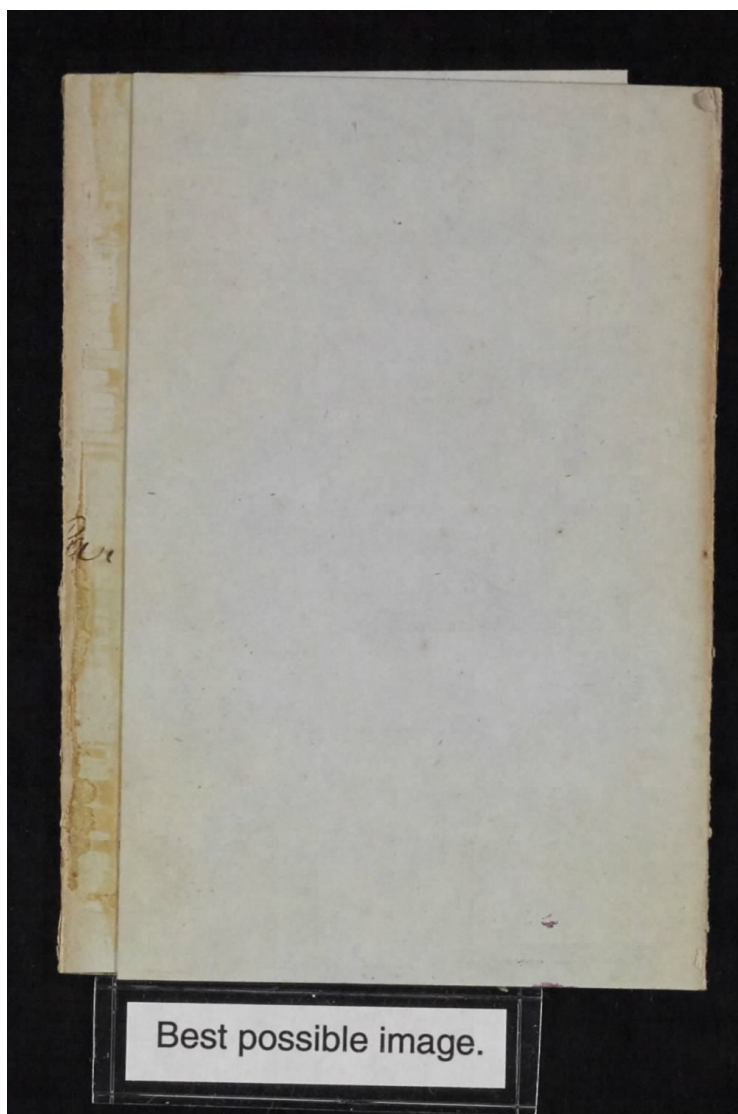

the duties of a soldier by reason of diseased testes
and a lameness in his hips by the fall of a tree
and a ^{gunshot} wound received in his leg. I would recom-
mend that he be discharged the service, and it is
my opinion that he is entitled to one half of a
full pension
